**A. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2008-05, PLEA: NO CONTEST**

**In the matter of the accusation against BRUINS ENTERPRISES, LLC dba THE BLUE LAGOON TROPICAL BAR AND GRILL, Restaurant General License No. 036, 658 Front Street, Suite Nos. 102, 103 & 104, Lahaina, Maui, Hawaii.**

Count 1. On July 6, 2007 at approximately 12:21 a.m., BRUINS ENTERPRISES, LLC dba THE BLUE LAGOON TROPICAL BAR AND GRILL, a restaurant general licensee, did, through its employee, sell, serve, or furnish liquor to a minor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(A) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(A) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

**B. COMPLAINT AND ACCUSATION NO. 2008-30, PLEA: NO CONTEST**

**In the matter of the accusation against BRUINS ENTERPRISES, LLC dba THE BLUE LAGOON TROPICAL BAR AND GRILL, Restaurant General License No. 036, 658 Front Street, Suite Nos. 102, 103 & 104, Lahaina, Maui, Hawaii.**

Count 1. On October 24, 2007 and October 25, 2007 between the approximate times of 9:30 p.m. and 12:30 a.m., BRUINS ENTERPRISES, LLC dba THE BLUE LAGOON TROPICAL BAR AND GRILL, a restaurant general licensee, did, through its employee(s), sell, serve, or furnish liquor to, or allow the consumption of liquor by Sean Verkler, who was at the time under the influence of liquor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, drugs, as defined in Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, or any combination thereof, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(B) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section

08-101-60(b)(1)(B) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

Count 4. On October 24, 2007 and October 25, 2007 between the approximate times of 9:30 p.m. and 1:00 a.m., BRUINS ENTERPRISES, LLC dba THE BLUE LAGOON TROPICAL BAR AND GRILL, a restaurant general licensee, did, through its employee(s), sell, serve, or furnish liquor to, or allow the consumption of liquor by Keone Brown, who was at the time under the influence of liquor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, drugs, as defined in Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, or any combination thereof, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(B) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(B) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.

Count 7. On October 24, 2007 and October 25, 2007 between the approximate times of 9:30 p.m. and 1:00 a.m., BRUINS ENTERPRISES, LLC dba THE BLUE LAGOON TROPICAL BAR AND GRILL, a restaurant general licensee, did, through its employee(s), sell, serve, or furnish liquor to, or allow the consumption of liquor by Angel Villagrana-Zamudio, who was at the time under the influence of liquor, as defined in Section 281-1 of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, drugs, as defined in Section 08-101-5 of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, or any combination thereof, contrary to Section 281-78(b)(1)(B) of the Hawaii Revised Statutes and Section 08-101-60(b)(1)(B) of the Rules of the Liquor Commission, County of Maui.
