WATER USE AND DEVELOPMENT PLAN

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 05-38, from Councilmember Michelle Anderson, relating to the Water Use and Development Plan required by Chapter 2.88A, Maui County Code, and Chapter 174C, Hawaii Revised Statutes (State Water Code).
2. Correspondence dated October 13, 2005, from the Chair of the Committee, transmitting a draft bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING COUNCIL APPROVAL OF CONTRACTS TO DEVELOP WATER RESOURCES". The purpose of the draft bill is to require Council approval of contracts to develop water resources.

STATUS:

The Committee may receive an update from the Department of Water Supply regarding ongoing water resource projects. The Committee may also consider whether to recommend passage of the draft bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 05-38 and other related action.

NOTE:

With reference to this agenda item, one or more executive meetings are anticipated to consult with legal counsel on questions and issues pertaining to the powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities of the County, the Council, and the Committee, pursuant to Section 92-5(a)(4), Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), and to deliberate concerning the authority of persons designated to negotiate the acquisition of public property, pursuant to Section 92-5(a)(3), HRS.

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WR-1 WATER SUPPLY RULES

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 05-46, from Councilmember Michelle Anderson, relating to Water Supply Rules.
2. Correspondence dated February 9, 2005, from the Chair of the Committee, transmitting a document entitled "Rules and Regulations of the Department of Water Supply" <<http://www.mauiwater.org/rules.html>>.
3. Recommitted Water Resources Committee Report No. 06-59, dated April 21, 2006, recommending passage on first reading of a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE REPEALING CHAPTER 2.88A, MAUI COUNTY CODE, AND AMENDING TITLE 14, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO THE COUNTY WATER CODE". The purpose of the proposed bill is to establish the County Water Code in Article 1 in Title 14 of the Maui County Code, including a provision that water from wells located in a contaminated aquifer underneath active agriculture shall not be provided for human consumption.

STATUS:

The Committee may discuss the progress of codifying the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Water Supply, as well as the proposed bill, focusing on the prohibited use of water from a contaminated aquifer for human consumption. No legislative action will be taken.
