ACCEPTING THE CENTRAL MAUI WASTEWATER RECLAMATION FACILITY STUDY AND CONCURRING RECOMMENDATIONS AND LONG TERM PLAN

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 05-366, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "ACCEPTING THE CENTRAL MAUI WASTEWATER RECLAMATION FACILITY STUDY AND CONCURRING RECOMMENDATIONS AND LONG TERM PLAN", along with a copy of the Study (dated August 12, 2005). The purpose of the proposed resolution is to accept the Study and recommendations of the Department of Public Works and Environmental Management concerning how the County of Maui can best meet the wastewater treatment and disposal needs for the Central Maui Region for the next 20-30 years.

STATUS:
