ACQUISITION OF REAL PROPERTY INTERESTS (WAILUKU)

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 06-58, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed resolution authorizing proceedings in eminent domain for the acquisition of real property interests at Wailuku, Maui, Hawaii, to make certain improvements on Market Street, including reconstructing pavement, installing drainage, installing curbs and sidewalks, and constructing driveways.
2. Correspondence dated March 6, 2006, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a revised proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING PROCEEDINGS IN EMINENT DOMAIN FOR THE ACQUISITION OF REAL PROPERTY INTERESTS AT WAILUKU, MAUI, HAWAII FOR MARKET STREET IMPROVEMENTS (WELLS STREET TO MOKUHAU ROAD), FEDERAL AID PROJECT STP-3405(1)". The purpose of the revised proposed resolution is to authorize proceedings in eminent domain in order to obtain portions of real property identified as TMK: (2) 3-4-32:001, (2) 3-4-33:009, and (2) 3-4-33:012.

PW-55 ACQUISITION OF REAL PROPERTY FOR NORTH-SOUTH COLLECTOR ROAD (KIHEI)

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 06-59, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING PROCEEDINGS IN EMINENT DOMAIN FOR THE ACQUISITION OF REAL PROPERTY SITUATED AT KIHEI, MAUI, HAWAII FOR NORTH-SOUTH COLLECTOR ROAD". The purpose of the proposed resolution is to authorize proceedings in eminent domain in order to obtain portions of real property identified as TMK: (2) 3-9-20:004 and (2) 3-9-20:016. This property is needed in order to complete construction of a section of the North-South Collector Road between Walua Place and Keonekai Road.

PW-58 DEDICATION OF ROADWAY LOTS FOR THE MAUNALOA VILLAGE SUBDIVISION (MOLOKAI)

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 06-71, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF ROADWAY LOTS FOR THE MAUNALOA VILLAGE SUBDIVISION, PURSUANT TO SECTION 3.44.015, MAUI COUNTY CODE". The purpose of the proposed resolution is to accept the dedication of roadway Lots 545, 548, 549, 551, 557, 553, 546, 555, 556, 613, 614, 615, 616, 617, 618, 619, 620, 713, 714, 715, and 720 in the Maunaloa Village Subdivision, Molokai (TMK: (2) 5-1-09:119 and (2) 5-1-10:137).
