OUTDOOR LIGHTING

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 00-125, from the Council Chair, transmitting a letter from a constituent relating to the abatement of light trespass.
2. Correspondence dated October 19, 2005, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a proposal for a low pressure sodium street light fixture test in four locations on the island of Maui for the purpose of soliciting public comment.
