OUTDOOR LIGHTING

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 00-125, from a former Council Chair, transmitting correspondence from a constituent relating to the abatement of light trespass.
2. Correspondence dated October 19, 2005, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, proposing a low pressure sodium street light fixture test in four locations on Maui for the purpose of soliciting public comment.
3. Correspondence dated January 26, 2006, from Councilmember Michael J. Molina, transmitting correspondence dated January 23, 2006 from Frank "Bud" Pikrone, General Manager, Wailea Community Association, transmitting a draft bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 20, MAUI COUNTY CODE, BY ADDING A NEW CHAPTER RELATING TO OUTDOOR LIGHTING". The purpose of the draft bill is to establish outdoor lighting standards, reduce light pollution, and enhance the night sky for astronomical research and preservation of wildlife.
