ACQUISITION OF PROPERTY FOR THE WAILUKU WASTEWATER FORCE MAIN REPLACEMENT (WAILUKU)

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 06-226, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed resolution to authorize proceedings in eminent domain for the acquisition of property for the Wailuku Force Main right-of-way.
2. Correspondence dated September 22, 2006, from a Deputy Corporation Counsel, transmitting a revised proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING PROCEEDINGS IN EMINENT DOMAIN FOR THE ACQUISITION OF REAL PROPERTY SITUATED AT WAILUKU, MAUI, HAWAII FOR WAILUKU WASTEWATER FORCE MAIN REPLACEMENT". The purpose of the revised proposed resolution is to authorize proceedings in eminent domain in order to obtain Lot 1-B-2, identified as TMK: (2) 3-4-27:001 (portion), comprising 23,556 square feet, for the Wailuku Force Main right-of-way.

PW-39 CENTRAL MAUI LANDFILL

PW-17 REQUIRING WIDER SIDEWALKS

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 05-194, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed bill relating to sidewalks.
2. Public Works Committee Report No. 05-131 (recommitted), attaching and recommending passage on first reading of a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 18.20.070, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO SIDEWALKS". The purpose of the proposed bill is to require sidewalks five feet wide on both sides of the street in all areas zoned residential, duplex, or in the County's interim zones.
3. Correspondence dated September 11, 2006, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting correspondence dated September 6, 2006, from Robert W. Riebling, P.E., Chairman, Subdivision Engineering Standards Committee (SESC), submitting SESC's recommendation for revisions to the proposed bill.
