HHS-4 COUNTY HOUSING POLICY

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

- 1. County Communication No. 05-132, from the Director of Housing and Human Concerns, transmitting a draft bill pertaining to County housing policies.
- 2. Correspondence dated February 22, 2006, from the Chair of the Committee, transmitting a revised draft bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A RESIDENTIAL WORKFORCE HOUSING POLICY". The purpose of the revised draft bill is to require the provision and maintenance of residential workforce housing units that will meet the needs of income-qualified households and special housing target groups.
