PEDESTRIAN SAFETY AT MAKANI ROAD AND MAKAWAO AVENUE

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 03-113, from Councilmember Michael J. Molina, transmitting correspondence from a constituent relating to pedestrian safety and vehicular speed at the intersection of Makani Road and Makawao Avenue in Makawao.

STATUS:

The Committee may consider whether to recommend any legislative action. The Committee may also consider other related action, including the possible filing of County Communication No. 03-113.

PWT-21 SOIL AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROL

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 03-132, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 20.08, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO SOIL EROSION AND SEDIMENTATION CONTROL". The purpose of the proposed bill is to: a) clarify certain definitions; b) permit the placing of sand on dunes for the purpose of rebuilding or enhancing the protective capacity and environmental quality of the coastal dune; c) permit the removal of sand from drainage outlets; and d) require a written evaluation, map, and other information for grubbing and grading permits on properties adjacent to the shoreline.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may consider other related action, including the possible filing of County Communication No. 03-132.

PWT-20 UNIFORM BUILDING CODE

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 03-131, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 16.26, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE". The purpose of the proposed bill is to: a) rescind the expiration date of the design registration program; b) require that low openings in exterior walls be protected by a guardrail; and c) clarify that salaries for Development Services Administration personnel may be funded by fees collected and deposited in the Plan Review, Permit Processing, and Inspection Revolving Fund.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may consider other related action, including the possible filing of County Communication No. 03-131.

PWT-15 ACCEPTING THE DEDICATION OF LAND IN KAMAOLE (KIHEI) FROM MAUI QUEST LLC

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 03-89, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF LAND IN KAMA'OLE (KIHEI) FROM MAUI QUEST LLC, PURSUANT TO SECTION 3.44.015, MAUI COUNTY CODE ". The purpose of the proposed resolution is to accept the dedication of roadway Lot A-7, along Kealii Alanui, Kihei, TMK No. (2) 3-9-018:092.
