NUMBERING OF BUILDINGS

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 03-133, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 12.32, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO NUMBERING OF BUILDINGS". The purposes of the proposed bill are to: a) require that property-address numbers are visible from the street; b) delete a provision relating to the Council's review of the house-numbering plan; c) clarify that the Department of Public Works and Environmental Management assigns street numbers; d) increase the fine for violation of Chapter 12.32; and e) enact non-substantive changes.

STATUS:

The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may consider other related action, including the possible filing of County Communication No. 03-133.

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PWT-12 GRANTING OF NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENTS FOR UNDERGROUND PRIVATE WATERLINE AND WATER METER ASSEMBLY PURPOSES (OLINDA)

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 03-82, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING THE GRANTING OF NON-EXCLUSIVE EASEMENTS ON COUNTY OF MAUI REAL PROPERTY TO ELIZABETH D. WILSON, TRUSTEE OF THE LAKALA TRUST FOR UNDERGROUND PRIVATE WATERLINE AND WATER METER ASSEMBLY PURPOSES". The purpose of the proposed resolution is to authorize the granting of non-exclusive easements to Elizabeth D. Wilson in connection with parcels of real property located along Ehu Road in Olinda, TMK Nos. (2) 2-4-013:067 and 070.
