**PWT-17 PEDESTRIAN SAFETY IN SCHOOL ZONES (INCLUDING MAKANI ROAD AND MAKAWAO AVENUE)**

**DESCRIPTION:** The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 03-113, from Councilmember Michael J. Molina, transmitting correspondence from a constituent relating to pedestrian safety and vehicular speed at the intersection of Makani Road and Makawao Avenue in Makawao; and
2. Correspondence dated June 26, 2003, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10.04, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO SCHOOL ZONE".
