Proceed to adjacent property, Kaunakakai Elementary School, at 30 Ailoa Street. Proceed in a northerly direction along Ailoa Street to the Department of Fire and Public Safety, Kaunakakai Station, located at 130 Ainoa Street. Proceed across Ainoa Street to its intersection with Ala Malama Street, to the Kaunakakai Little League Park, and finally proceed across Ala Malama Street to the Molokai Youth Center, located at 210 Kolapa Street.
