### **PROPOSED BILL AMENDING SECTION 16.26.106, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE AND PLAN REVIEW WAIVERS**

#### **DESCRIPTION:**

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 04-47, from the Planning Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 16.26.106, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE AND PLAN REVIEW WAIVERS". The purpose of the proposed bill is to exclude from the plan review waiver process any property located within a historic district.
2. Correspondence dated April 5, 2004, from Councilmember Jo Anne Johnson, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 16.26, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO PLAN REVIEW WAIVERS". The purpose of the proposed bill is to repeal Section 106.4.1(b) of the Uniform Building Code, which allows for plan review waivers.

**PWT-28                    PROPOSED RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MAUI ELECTRIC COMPANY, LIMITED AND VERIZON HAWAII, INC., TO REPLACE AND INSTALL UTILITY POLES ON ULUMAU PLACE, HAIKU**

**DESCRIPTION:** The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 04-127, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "AUTHORIZING MAUI ELECTRIC COMPANY, LIMITED AND VERIZON HAWAII INC., TO REPLACE AND INSTALL UTILITY POLES ON ULUMAU PLACE, HAIKU, MAUI". The purpose of the proposed resolution is to authorize the replacement of two utility poles (30 and 35 feet, respectively) and the installation of three new utility poles (40 feet each) along Ulumau Place in Haiku.

The purpose of the revised proposed resolution is to authorize the dedication of access and utility Lot 102 for the Ke Ali`i Kai Subdivision in Kihei.
