ABANDONED VEHICLES AND ILLEGAL DUMPING OF TRASH

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. No. 03-165, from Councilmember Michael J. Molina, relating to the matter of abandoned vehicles.
2. Correspondence dated July 28, 2004, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting the following:
 - A. A proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 20.20, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO LITTER CONTROL". The purposes of the proposed bill are to establish a derelict and abandoned vehicle abatement program (DAVAP) and authorize the Director of Finance to adopt administrative rules to implement the DAVAP; and

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B. DERELICT AND ABANDONED VEHICLE ABATEMENT PROGRAM". The purpose of the draft administrative rules is to establish DAVAP procedures pertaining to the towing and disposal of unwanted vehicles.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the possible filing of County Communication No. 03-165 and other related action.

**PWT-24 PROPOSED RESOLUTION ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF
SEWERLINE EASEMENTS, LEVAL TRACT (WAILUKU)**

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 04-184, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF EASEMENTS PURSUANT TO SECTION 3.44.015, MAUI COUNTY CODE". The purpose of the proposed resolution is to accept nonexclusive easements to reconstruct, maintain, operate, repair, and remove sewer-system improvements installed in connection with the construction of the subdivision of Lot B of the Leval Tract in Wailuku (TMK: (2) 3-4-33:003).
