FLOODING IN THE LAHAINA AREA

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 02-43, from Councilmember Robert Carroll, relating to flooding in the Lahaina area.

STATUS:

The Committee may receive presentations regarding the following:

1. The Lahaina Watershed Flood Control Project. This project is a cooperative effort of the West Maui Soil and Water Conservation District; the Natural Resources Conservation Service, U.S. Department of Agriculture (NRCS); and the County of Maui. The project proposes to implement a storm water diversion channel in the Lahaina Watershed that starts south of Lahainaluna Road and extends across the watershed to Kauaula Stream. A second channel is proposed to extend 3,600 feet in a southerly direction from Kauaula Stream.
2. The Lahaina Town Drainage Master Plan. This comprehensive drainage master plan consists of the systematic development of storm drainage improvements from Kahoma Stream to Kauaula Stream.

The Committee may also consider the possible filing of County Communication No. 02-43 and other related action.

PWT-2 DEDICATION OF ROADWAY LOTS (KIHEI FARM SUBDIVISION AND KALAMA COMMERCIAL PROJECT)

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 02-101, from the former Director of Public Works and Waste Management, transmitting a proposed resolution entitled "ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF ROADWAY LOTS PURSUANT TO SECTION 3.44.015, MAUI COUNTY CODE" (Lots 11-B and 12-A-2, Kihei Farm Subdivision; and Lots B and C, Kalama Commercial Project).
2. Correspondence dated May 31, 2002, from the Department of the Corporation Counsel, transmitting a revised proposed resolution entitled "ACCEPTING DEDICATION OF ROADWAY LOTS FOR THE KIHEI FARM SUBDIVISION/KALAMA COMMERCIAL PROJECT PURSUANT TO SECTION 3.44.015, MAUI COUNTY CODE". The revised proposed resolution incorporates technical revisions.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend adoption of the revised proposed resolution, with or without further revisions. The Committee may also consider the possible filing of County Communication No. 02-101 and other related action.
