### **OUTDOOR LIGHTING**

**DESCRIPTION:**

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 00-125, from the Council Chair, transmitting correspondence from a constituent relating to the abatement of light trespass.
2. Correspondence dated November 10, 2004, from the Department of Corporation Counsel, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 20, MAUI COUNTY CODE, BY ADDING A NEW CHAPTER RELATING TO OUTDOOR LIGHTING". The purpose of the proposed bill, which is modeled on the County of Hawaii's Outdoor Lighting ordinance (Article 9 of Chapter 14, Hawaii County Code), is to establish standards for the installation of all outdoor lighting fixtures.

**STATUS:**

The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the possible filing of County Communication No. 00-125 and other related action.
