ASSESSING THE IMPACTS OF POTENTIAL MILITARY CONFLICT

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of a Miscellaneous Communication, dated March 7, 2003, from the County Clerk, referring the matter of assessing the impacts of potential military conflict on the County of Maui and transmitting a copy of Resolution No. 03-31 entitled "URGING THE ADMINISTRATION TO DEVELOP A PROACTIVE MITIGATION PLAN TO ADDRESS THE IMPACTS OF POTENTIAL MILITARY CONFLICT". The purpose of the resolution is to request that the Mayor develop a proactive plan to address potential impacts of military conflict on the County's economy, delivery of goods and services, infrastructure and public safety.

STATUS:

Resolution No. 03-31 was adopted by the Council at its meeting of March 7, 2003. The Committee may consider whether to recommend any legislative action. The Committee may also consider other related action, including the possible filing of the Miscellaneous Communication.
