DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

- 1. Correspondence dated June 13, 2003, from the Council Chair, transmitting correspondence dated June 12, 2003 (received on June 13, 2003), from the Director of Housing and Human Concerns, along with a proposed resolution entitled, "APPROVING AMENDMENTS TO THE LANAI CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT PURSUANT TO SECTION 201G-118, HAWAII REVISED STATUTES." The purpose of the proposed resolution is to approve amendments to the original Lanai City Redevelopment Project, approved by the Council in 1996 (Resolution No. 96-31), which amendments include the consolidation of selected small lots, additional new homes and rental units, new home and rental unit designs, optional attached and free-standing carports, and additional building material and lot improvement exemptions.
