GRANTS MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 03-163, from Councilmember Joseph Pontanilla, relating to the matter of the Department of Housing and Human Concerns' Grants Management program and transmitting an assessment of the County's various grants programs completed in 2001 under the previous Administration's Service, Efficiency, Results, Valuation (SERV) initiative.
