### COUNTY HOUSING POLICY

#### DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 05-132, from the Director of Housing and Human Concerns, transmitting a draft bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.86 OF THE MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO COUNTY HOUSING POLICIES". The purpose of the draft bill is to replace the County's "Affordable Housing Program" with a "Maui County Housing Policy".
2. Correspondence dated April 18, 2005, from the Chair of the Committee, transmitting the following:
  - a. A document entitled "Affordable Housing for Maui County" submitted by the Board of Directors of Maui Tomorrow Foundation, Inc.
  - b. A document entitled "Santa Cruz County Affordable Housing Guidelines, 2004 Edition, Revised April 12, 2004".

- c. County of Hawaii Ordinance No. 05-23, entitled "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 11 OF THE HAWAII COUNTY CODE 1983 (1995 EDITION), TO REVISE THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING POLICY FOR THE COUNTY OF HAWAII".
3. Correspondence dated June 8, 2005, from the Council Chair, transmitting a document dated May 18, 2005, entitled "AFFORDABLE HOUSING NOW AN INCLUSIONARY HOUSING MEASURE" prepared by the Maui Nui Housing Task Force, which includes the following:
  - a. A draft bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.86 OF THE MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO COUNTY HOUSING POLICIES". The purpose of the draft bill is to establish an inclusionary housing policy for the County.
  - b. A draft resolution entitled "ADOPTING THE MAUI COUNTY AFFORDABLE HOUSING GUIDELINES PURSUANT TO TITLE 2.86, MAUI COUNTY CODE". The purpose of the draft resolution is to establish a set of affordable housing guidelines for the County.
  - c. A draft bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING TRUST FUND".  
The purpose of the draft bill is to create a dedicated fund to be used for affordable housing.
4. Correspondence dated December 2, 2005, from the Chair of the Committee, transmitting a draft bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A RESIDENTIAL WORKFORCE HOUSING POLICY". The purpose of the draft bill is to encourage the provision and maintenance of residential workforce housing units and related programs which will meet the needs of income qualified households and related special housing target groups.
