OCEAN RECREATIONAL ACTIVITY PERMITS (ORAP)

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 04-143, from Councilmember Johnson, relating to possible revisions to Ordinance No. 3143, which established Article X, Chapter 13.04, Maui County Code, entitled "COMMERCIAL OCEAN RECREATIONAL ACTIVITY".
2. Miscellaneous Communication, dated September 19, 2003, relating to penalties in Chapter 13.04, Maui County Code.
3. Miscellaneous Communication, dated September 19, 2003, relating to beach parks where ocean recreational activities are prohibited.
4. Correspondence dated January 26, 2005, from the Chair of the Budget and Finance Committee, transmitting a letter from the Director of Parks and Recreation, dated January 21, 2005, regarding the proposed ORAP fee for Fiscal Year 2006.
