PARKING ON BALDWIN AVENUE (PAIA)

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of the following:

1. County Communication No. 04-183, from Councilmember Michael Molina, transmitting correspondence from Mary J. Cochran, President, Paia Plantation, Inc., requesting time-restricted parking on Baldwin Avenue in Paia.
2. Correspondence dated November 18, 2004, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10.48.090, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO LIMITED PARKING--SIXTY MINUTES". The purpose of the proposed bill is to establish a one-hour parking restriction on the east side of Baldwin Avenue, from Pua Place to Melia Place.

STATUS:

The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 04-183 and other related action.

PW-9 COUNTY SPEED HUMP PROGRAM

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 05-95, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed bill entitled “A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 12.48, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO SPEED HUMPS”. The purpose of the proposed bill is to: allow the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management to establish a distance from a proposed speed hump from which at least eighty percent of abutting property owners must consent; add a requirement for at least eighty percent property owner consent on a particular block where a speed hump is to be placed; add the definition of a “block”; correct references to the name of the Department and the Director’s title; and to make some grammatical changes.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 05-95 and other related action.

PW-30 LOADING ZONE ON FRONT STREET (LAHAINA)

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of the following:
1. County Communication No. 04-234, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed bill to establish a tow-away zone between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m.; and between the hours of 1:00 p.m. and 2:30 p.m. in front of Kamehameha III Elementary School.
2. Correspondence dated March 7, 2005, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a revised proposed bill entitled “A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 10.56A.010, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO LOADING ZONES”. The revised proposed bill incorporates revisions to establish a loading zone.

STATUS: The Committee may consider whether to recommend passage of the revised proposed bill on first reading, with or without revisions. The Committee may also consider the filing of County Communication No. 04-234 and other related action.
