REQUIRING WIDER SIDEWALKS

DESCRIPTION:

The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 05-194, from the Director of Public Works and Environmental Management, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 18.20.070, MAUI COUNTY CODE, RELATING TO SIDEWALKS". The purpose of the proposed bill is to require sidewalks five feet wide on both sides of the street in all areas zoned residential, duplex, or in the County's interim zones.

UNIFORM BUILDING CODE AND PLAN REVIEW WAIVERS

DESCRIPTION: The Committee is in receipt of County Communication No. 04-47, from the Planning Director, transmitting a proposed bill entitled "A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 16.26.106, MAUI COUNTY CODE, PERTAINING TO THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE AND PLAN REVIEW WAIVERS". The purpose of the proposed bill is to exclude from the plan review waiver process any property located within a historic district.
