Section 8.1 Water

Pg. 8-3, Line 44, add new Policy 12: [Encourage CWRM to establish and adhere to interim stream flow standards.](#)

Pg. 8-4, Action 8.1.05, Edit: Reconvene the Moloka`i Water Working Group and encourage all water purveyors to work together to address future water demand, [sustainability, quality](#), and supply issues.

Section 8.3 Stormwater Management

Page 8-9, Line 37: Delete “large” before “landowners”.

Page 8-9, Footnote 5: Delete “Refers to definition...” and add [Green infrastructure uses natural systems, constructed soil, rock, or plant-based systems for surface and stormwater management.](#)

Pg. 8-19, Line 4-5, delete Policy 11

Pg. 8-20, delete Action 8.5.12

Section 8.7 Telecommunication

Pg. 8-25, Line 9, Policy 6, Edit: ~~Require~~[Encourage](#) telecommunication providers to expand the coverage and provide more reliable service throughout the island.

Section 9.1 Parks and Recreation

Pg. 9-5, Action 9.1.07, Edit: Coordinate planning, design, and construction of a new Kaunakakai Gymnasium and athletic building that meets Moloka`i’s unique sports needs and serves as a hardened civil defense community shelter for disasters, [and is located outside of the flood zone.](#)

Pg. 9-8, Add new Action 9.2.06: [Explore the possibility of collaborating with an animal rescue organization to establish an animal holding facility on Moloka`i. Lead: MPD, Partners: Animal rescue organization](#)

Pg. 9-10, Lines 28 – 30: Delete Policy 1 because it is a duplicate of action 9.3.03

Pg. 9-10, Lines 32 – 34: Delete Policy 2 because it is a duplicate of action 9.3.02

9.4 Education

Pg. 9-12, Lines 12-13, Edit: There are ~~four~~three public elementary schools on Moloka`i: a) Kaunakakai, b) ~~Kualapu`u, c)~~ Maunaloa and ~~d)~~ Kilohana located in ~~Ho`olehua~~ Ualapue. There is also a public-private charter school in Kualapu`u.

Page 9-12, line 28; Update enrollment figures to 2016, when available.

9.6 Cemeteries

Pg. 9-20, Lines 4 – 8, Edit:

Moloka`i has ~~#~~numerous cemeteries maintained by various entities. The County of Maui Department of Public Works maintains three cemeteries including the Veteran's Cemetery in Ho`olehua, Ualapue Cemetery, and Kapa`akea Cemetery. The Ualapue Cemetery is closed and no longer accepting burials. The Kapa`akea Cemetery is nearing capacity, with less than 50 burial sites remaining. Other cemeteries on Moloka`i include ~~two~~Kanakaloloa Cemetery at Ho`olehua and Homelani Cemetery at Manawainui maintained by DHHL, Maunaloa Cemetery owned by Molokai Ranch and maintained by the community, and several private cemeteries maintained by families or churches.
