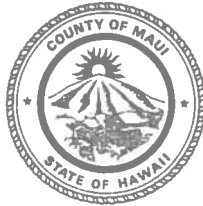

TERMINATION OF EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 127A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, I, ALAN M. ARAKAWA, Mayor of the County of Maui, did proclaim and declare that a local state of emergency existed for the entire County of Maui effective 2:00 p.m., HST, July 22, 2016, due to the imminent danger from Tropical Storm DARBY's approach to the County of Maui; and

WHEREAS, Tropical Storm DARBY passed through Maui County at tropical storm strength on July 24, 2016, bringing heavy rains, localized flooding, and tropical storm force winds with high gusts; and

WHEREAS, Tropical Storm DARBY proceeded west-northwest and is now out of range of the County of Maui; and

WHEREAS, the tropical storm warning issued by the Central Pacific Hurricane Center for Maui County was canceled as of July 24, 2016, at 5:00 p.m., HST;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Chapter 127A, I, ALAN M. ARAKAWA, Mayor of the County of Maui, do hereby proclaim and declare that the local state of emergency previously proclaimed and declared for the entire County of Maui due to Tropical Storm DARBY is hereby terminated effective 8:00 a.m., HST, July 25, 2016.
