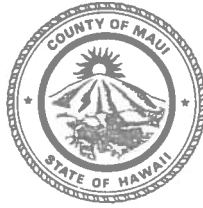

TERMINATION OF EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority vested in me by the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, and the Constitution and laws of the State of Hawaii, and the authority granted to me by Mayor Alan M. Arakawa, by his letter dated September 1, 2016, to serve as Acting Mayor during Mayor Arakawa's absence from 10:00 a.m., Thursday, September 1, 2016, until his return, anticipated to be Sunday, September 11, 2016, at approximately 4:11 p.m., I, KEITH A. REGAN, Acting Mayor of the County of Maui of the State of Hawaii, did proclaim and declare that a local state of emergency existed for the entire County of Maui effective as of 2:24 p.m., HST, September 1, 2016, due to the imminent danger from Hurricane LESTER's approach to the County of Maui; and

WHEREAS, Hurricane LESTER passed north of Maui County as a Hurricane on September 3, 2016, generating high surf, isolated heavy rains, flooding, thunderstorms and gusty winds; and

WHEREAS, Hurricane LESTER proceeded west-northwest and is now out of range of the County of Maui; and

WHEREAS, the Hurricane watch issued by the Central Pacific Hurricane Center for Maui County was canceled as of September 3, 2016, at 5:00 a.m., HST;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Chapter 127A, I, KEITH A. REGAN, Acting Mayor of the County of Maui, do hereby proclaim and declare that the local state of emergency previously proclaimed and declared for the entire County of Maui due to Hurricane LESTER is hereby terminated effective 0800 a.m., HST, September 4, 2016.
