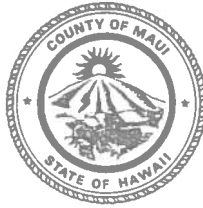

FIRST SUPPLEMENTARY PROCLAMATION

By the authority vested in me as Mayor by the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, and the Constitution and laws of the State of Hawaii, in order to provide relief for disaster damages, losses, and suffering, and to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the people, I, ALAN M. ARAKAWA, Mayor of the County of Maui of the State of Hawaii, did determine, designate and proclaim, pursuant to Chapter 127A, Hawaii Revised Statutes (“HRS”) that a local state of emergency existed as of 1:30 p.m., on the 14th day of September, 2016, due to extensive rains and flooding in the County of Maui beginning on September 13, 2016, and which Proclamation remains in effect at this time. I hereby determine, designate and proclaim further as follows:

WHEREAS, Chapter 127A, Hawaii Revised Statutes (“HRS”) empowers me, Alan M. Arakawa, as Mayor of the County of Maui of the State of Hawaii, as the sole judge that an emergency or disaster has occurred or of the existence of imminent danger or threat of an emergency or disaster in any portion of the county; and

WHEREAS, the Iao Valley and Wailuku River areas on the Island of Maui within the County of Maui continue to experience damage to personal and public property resulting from the severe storms, heavy rains, flash flooding, landslides, mudslides, and extensive erosion which began on September 13, 2016, which were included in the emergency Proclamation of September 14, 2016; and

WHEREAS, extensive emergency protective measures have been ongoing since the events of September 13, 2016, to stabilize inundated areas, remove flood debris, restore normal drainage, and prevent further damage to private and public property resulting from the heavy rains, flash flooding, landslides, mudslides, and extensive erosion which began on September 13, 2016, and to provide for the health, safety, and welfare of the people, particularly in the Iao Valley and Wailuku River areas; and

WHEREAS, there is an ongoing need for government agencies and representatives from the private sector to provide immediate services to our island residents, it has become necessary to supplement the Proclamation of September 14, 2016, in order to extend the period of time required to protect

public and private property, and to ameliorate and mitigate hazardous situations resulting from the September 13, 2016, events;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 14(b), HRS Chapter 127A, I, ALAN M. ARAKAWA, Mayor of the County of Maui, do hereby further determine that an emergency and/or disaster has occurred in the County of Maui, and continues to threaten both public and private property and the health, safety and welfare of the people of the County of Maui, particularly in the Iao Valley and Wailuku River areas, and I do hereby declare that all the provisions of the Proclamation of September 14, 2016, shall remain in full force and effect and are hereby included in the provisions of this First Supplementary Proclamation. I further declare and proclaim that the disaster emergency relief period shall continue through January 13, 2017, and that any projects initiated under the original Proclamation or this First Supplementary Proclamation, shall continue to be subject to this First Supplementary Proclamation until project acceptance and any final accounting or payment obligations, whichever is later. Pursuant to this First Supplementary Proclamation, I hereby exercise any and all powers listed in Sections 12 and 13 of Chapter 127A, HRS.
