Why are we here today?

The Long Range Division of the County's Planning Department is updating the West Maui Community Plan. In 2017, the Division focused on public outreach with the goal of ensuring all community voices are heard. We are here today to share what we have heard throughout last year's community engagement process.

Here is a snap-shot of how we engaged the community:

5 small group presentations/talk story sessions with over 130 participants
