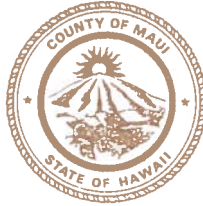

TERMINATION OF EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION


WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority vested in the Mayor by the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, and by Chapter 127A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, an Emergency Proclamation was declared on November 29, 2017, to provide preemptive and protective action to mitigate the imminent danger to vehicles and pedestrians in the Piiholo Road area on the island of Maui from an excessive number of dead eucalyptus trees situated in the County-owned rights of way and areas immediately adjacent thereto along Piiholo Road; and

WHEREAS, the Emergency Proclamation was twice extended, by the First Supplementary Proclamation issued January 23, 2018, and by the Second Supplementary Proclamation issued March 23, 2018, extending the disaster period through June 30, 2018, or until the work was completed, the project accepted, and final accounting and payment obligations made, whichever occurred first; and

WHEREAS, work to mitigate the danger by removal of an excessive number of dead trees has now been completed, the project accepted, and final accounting and payment obligations made;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 14(b), HRS Chapter 127A, I, ALAN M. ARAKAWA, Mayor of the County of Maui, do hereby proclaim and declare that the local state of emergency previously proclaimed and declared for the Piiholo Road area on the island of Maui is hereby terminated effective 12 p.m., Hawaii Standard Time, June 7, 2018.
