This includes installation of a temporary Motor Control Center (MCC), demolition of existing MCC, installation of new MCC and installation of other project related improvements.

Baseyard Office located at 614 Palapala Drive, Kahului, Maui, Hawaii, 96793. An on-site project tour will be held following the pre-bid conference. Directions to the site will be provided during the pre-bid conference. Bidders are required to provide their own transportation.

Bidders are required to comply with the newest procurement code, HRS, Chapter 103-D, any rules and regulations and policy directives issued with respects to Chapter 103-D and any amendments. Bids must be accompanied by an acceptable form of bid security in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the based bid, including additives, payable to the "County of Maui".
