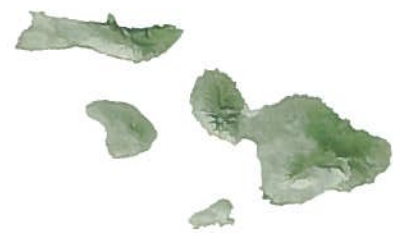
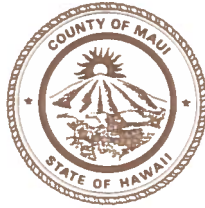

TERMINATION OF EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION


WHEREAS, pursuant to the authority vested in the Mayor by the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, and by Chapter 127A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, I, MICHAEL P. VICTORINO, Mayor of the County of Maui of the State of Hawaii, issued an Emergency Proclamation on July 11, 2019, at 6:54 p.m., due to the imminent danger to the residents of Maui County from a large, out-of-control brush fire which started at the intersection of Kuihelani Highway and Waiko Road, Maui island; and

WHEREAS, the large brush fire threatened residents and businesses located in Ma`alaea, the central valley of Maui island, and portions of North Kihei, resulting in extended road closures and evacuations of residences and businesses in those threatened areas; and


WHEREAS, the Maui Fire Department declared that the large brush fire was fully contained on July 15, 2019, and further action by the Maui Fire Department to extinguish the fire has been completed;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Chapter 127A, I, MICHAEL P. VICTORINO, Mayor of the County of Maui, of the State of Hawaii, do hereby proclaim and declare that the local state of emergency previously proclaimed and declared for the entire County of Maui by my July 11, 2019 Proclamation is hereby terminated effective 2:30p.m., HST, July 30, 2019.
