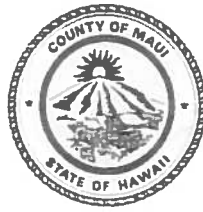

PROCLAMATION

By the authority vested in me as Mayor by the Revised Charter of the County of Maui (1983), as amended, and the Constitution and laws of the State of Hawaii, in order to provide relief for disaster damages, losses, and suffering, and to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the people, I, MICHAEL P. VICTORINO, Mayor of the County of Maui of the State of Hawaii, hereby determine, designate and proclaim as follows:

WHEREAS, Chapter 127A, Hawaii Revised Statutes ("HRS") empowers me, MICHAEL P. VICTORINO, as Mayor of the County of Maui of the State of Hawaii, as the sole judge of the existence of imminent danger or threat of an emergency or disaster in any portion of the county; and

WHEREAS, at approximately 1:30 p.m. today, October 22, 2019, a brush fire broke out near the Kapalua Airport Area, in Kahana, Maui, Hawaii, and was fanned by strong trade winds causing the fire to spread toward businesses and residences in the Kahana area. Heavy smoke from the fire impairs visibility, and several roadways, including Honoapi'ilani, were closed due to danger to motorists, residences, businesses, County, State, and private property. The fire remains out-of-control, strong winds continue to fan the fire, and the fire poses an imminent threat to life and property. Based on the fact that the County has been fighting this fire since approximately 1:30 p.m. on October 22, 2019, and it remains out-of-control at this time, and based upon the expertise available to me, I have determined that the brush fire poses an imminent danger of death, injury, and property damage to the people of Maui County; and

WHEREAS, the fire has burned homes, and evacuations were requested for some residential areas proximate to the fire as preemptive and protective action, and ongoing evacuations are likely, and an emergency shelter has been activated in the Lahaina Civic Center's Social Hall, a continued emergency response is warranted to provide for the health, safety, and welfare of the people; and

WHEREAS, there is need for government agencies and representatives from the private sector to mobilize and provide immediate services to our island residents and visitors to the island of Maui and to mitigate hazardous situations associated with the fire and actions by people to evade the fire hazard;


NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 14(b), HRS Chapter 127A, I, MICHAEL P. VICTORINO, Mayor of the County of Maui, do hereby determine that the County of Maui is in imminent danger and that there is the threat of an emergency or disaster for a portion of the county due to the out-of-control brush fire located on the west side of Maui island, spreading rapidly by winds, and I DO HEREBY PROCLAIM that a local state of emergency exists as of 1:40 pm (time), this 22nd day of October, 2019, which shall continue until terminated by any separate proclamation, or which shall automatically terminate sixty days after issuance of this PROCLAMATION, whichever occurs first. Pursuant to this Proclamation, I hereby exercise any and all powers listed in Sections 12 and 13 of Chapter 127A, HRS.
