Nominations are being accepted for women who reside in Maui County to be honored as “Women of Excellence” during Women’s History Month (March 2020). Awards will be determined based on the National Women’s History Month theme:

**“VALIANT WOMEN OF THE VOTE”:**

**honoring “The brave women who fought to win suffrage rights for women, and for the women who continue to fight for the voting rights of others.”**

The National Women's History Month theme for 2020 celebrates the women who have fought for woman’s right to vote in the United States. In recognition of the centennial of the 19<sup>th</sup> Amendment, we will honor women from the original suffrage movement as well as 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> century women who have continued the struggle.

Four (4) Maui County women will be honored in the following categories:

- (1) Young Woman of Promise (14-21 years old)
- (2) Woman of Excellence (22 years old to 59)
- (3) Unsung Hero (60 years old & up)
- (4) Honorary Historical Award (Posthumous)
