EMERGENCY RULES

- Very similar to Gov. David Ige's proclamation.
- Where there is a conflict between County rules and Governor's rules, follow the stricter rule.
 - Example: Governor allows gatherings of less than 10 people.
WE DO NOT.
- Household members can walk, run, or bike outside together.
- If you need groceries, have one person gather and return home. When they come home, they should disinfect before going inside.

NEW UPDATES

- Drop boxes will soon be available for all payments (i.e. refuse, water, property tax, vehicle registration).
- You can also mail payments, pay online, or pay at kiosks. All service fees are being waived.
- All County offices are closed to the public. Allows us to save our protective gear for our first responders.
- All Drivers Licenses and State IDs expiring March 23 through May 15 have an additional 90 days from expiration.

MAUI POLICE DEPARTMENT

Law enforcement and using compassion and best practices by law enforcement agencies nationwide.

Enforcement Approach:

1. Educating public
2. Warnings & Reprimands
3. Citation
4. Arrest

MAUI FIRE DEPARTMENT

- County Beach Parks are CLOSED; Beaches are OPEN
- Lifeguard Towers are CLOSED
- Ocean Safety Officers will be educating people on the beach and responding to emergency situations

PARKS AND RECREATION

- Portable toilets available at a number of locations. List is available on the County of Maui website
- More portable toilets to be added in the coming days
- Water is still on at parks for hand washing and cleanliness

TRANSPORTATION

- Public transportation is still operational.
- For essential travel only; practice social distancing where possible
- All cash purchases of bus passes must be done on the bus.
- Buses being sanitized multiple times a day.
- Wharf Cinema Center Management Office and Queen Kaahumanu Center Transit Hub Greeter are not selling passes, until further notice.

HOUSING & HUMAN CONCERNS

Section 8

- Still processing Section 8 rent payments and applications. Also requests for adjustments are being done.

Kaunoa Senior Services

- Still doing **Senior Transports** and **Meals on Wheels**
- All Kaunoa leisure and congregate activities are **CANCELED**

Early Childhood Resource Center

- Working on plan to connect those essential workers in need of childcare with appropriate resources.

HOUSING & HUMAN CONCERNS

Immigrant Services Division

- No in-person appointments are offered; please call

Homeless Program Division

- Support to homeless provider agencies
- Working with agencies statewide, including Governor's Homeless Coordinator, Department of Health, HUD and Coordinators from other counties.

OTHER DEPARTMENTS

PUBLIC WORKS

- Maintain operations of all three divisions.
- No services have been curtailed
- Working with State DOT on restricting select roads/highways to local traffic only

ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT

- DO NOT flush sanitation wipes down toilet
- Sewer and Refuse services to continue

WATER SUPPLY

- Water service to continue

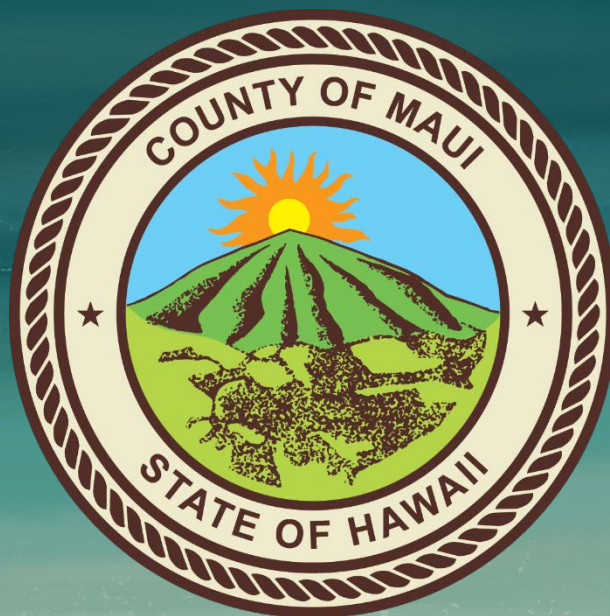
OTHER DEPARTMENTS
