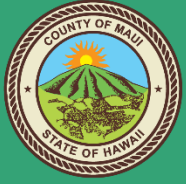

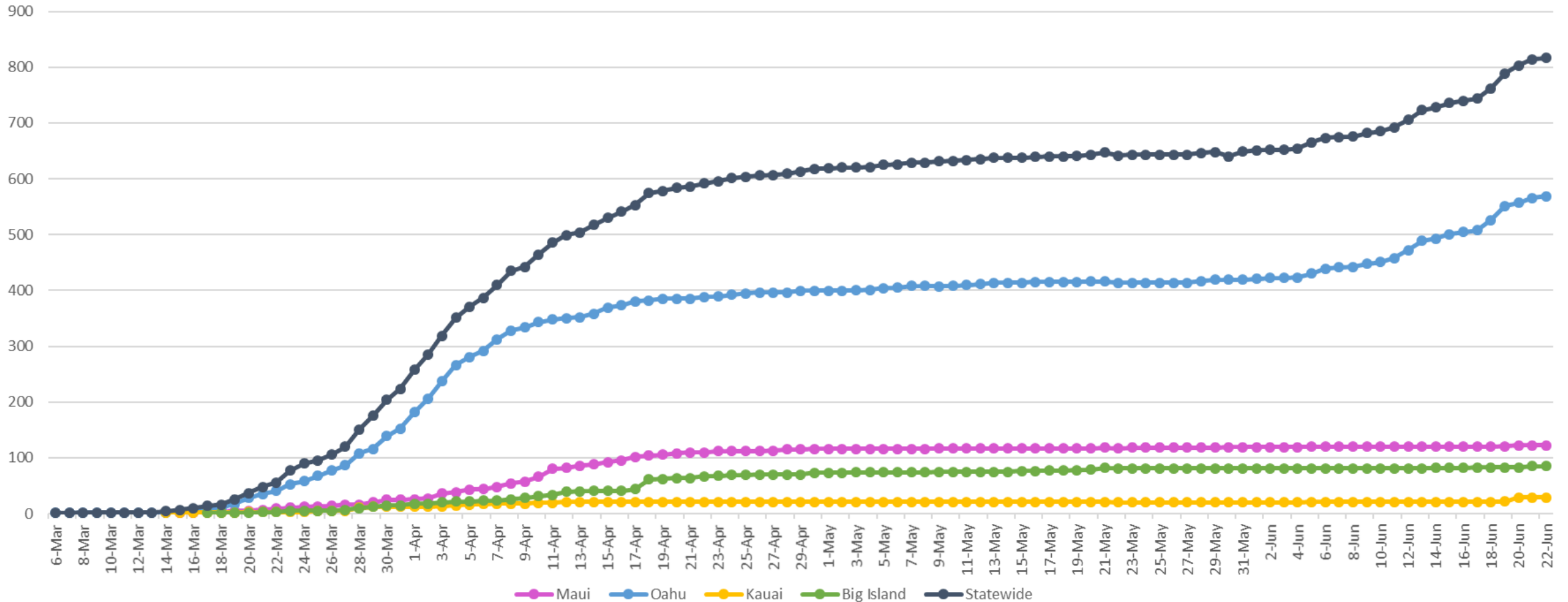

Cumulative Total COVID-19 Cases Showing Statewide Total and by County (6/22/20)

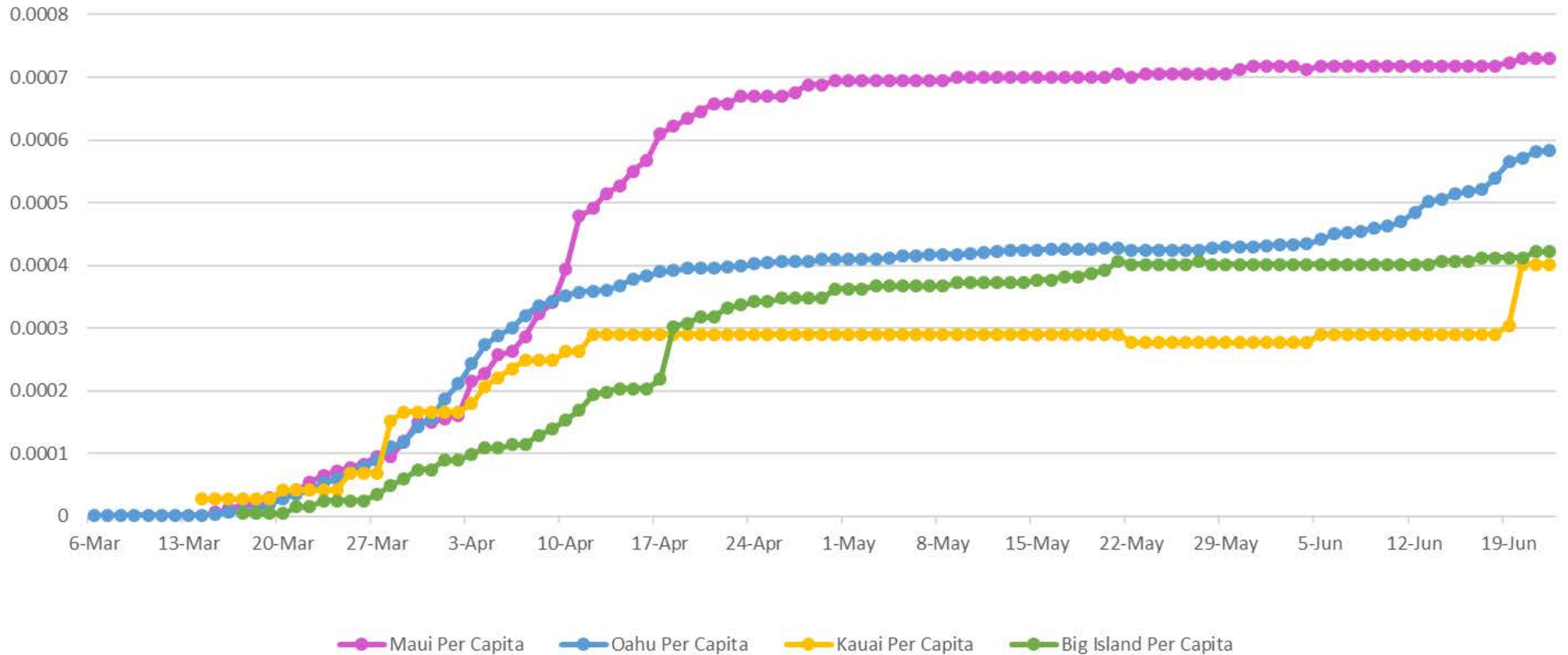

Positive COVID-19 Cases Per Capita by County, June 22, 2020

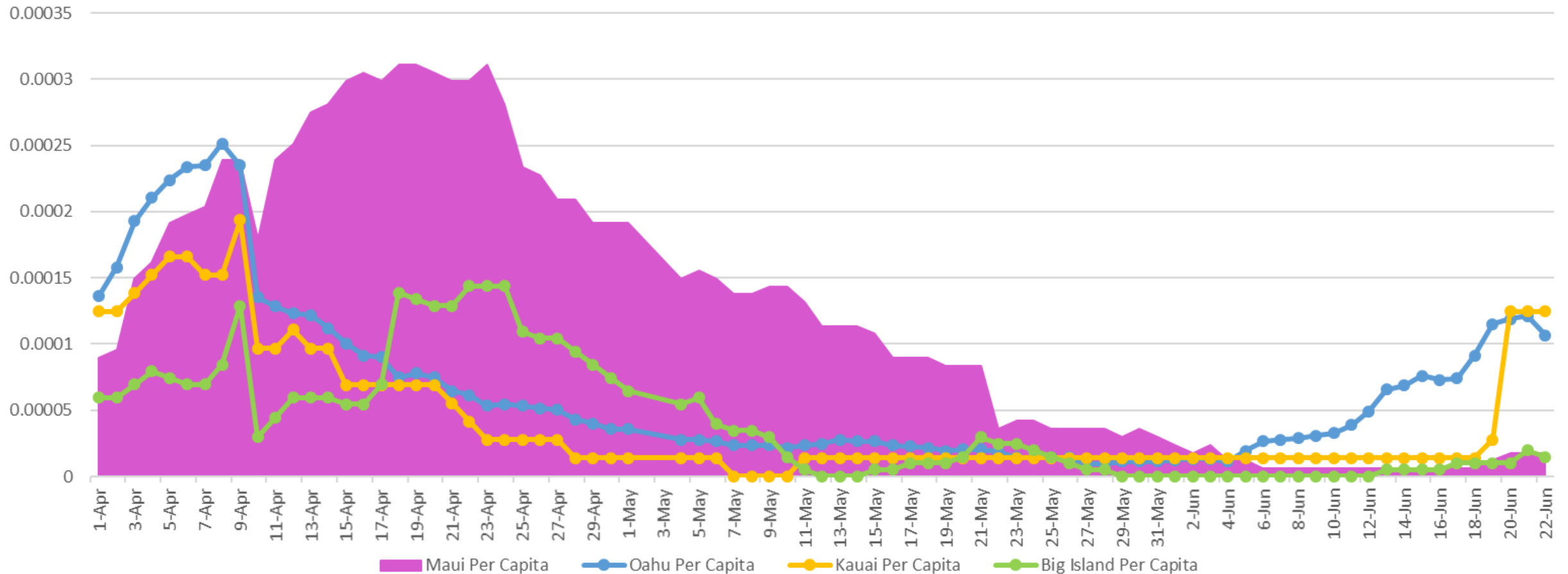

Active Cases in Isolation per Capita by County (June 22, 2020)

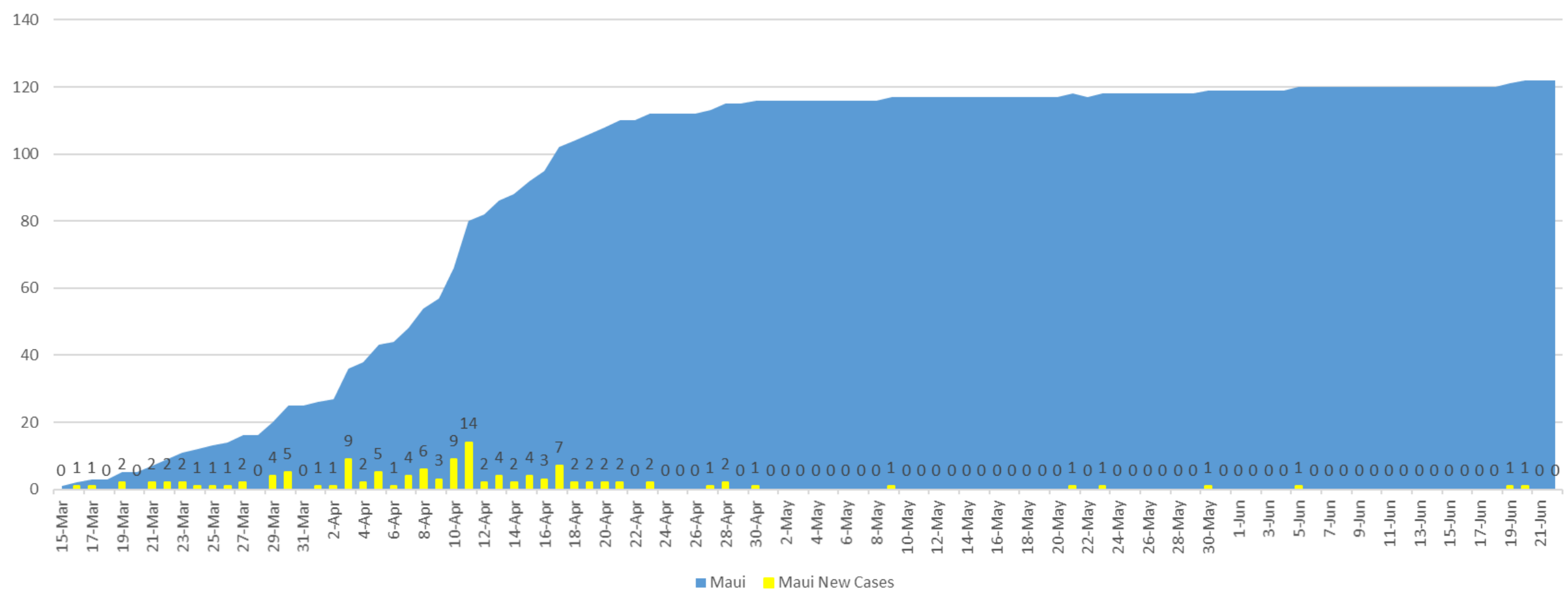

Cumulative Maui Cases compared to New Cases by Day (6/22/20)

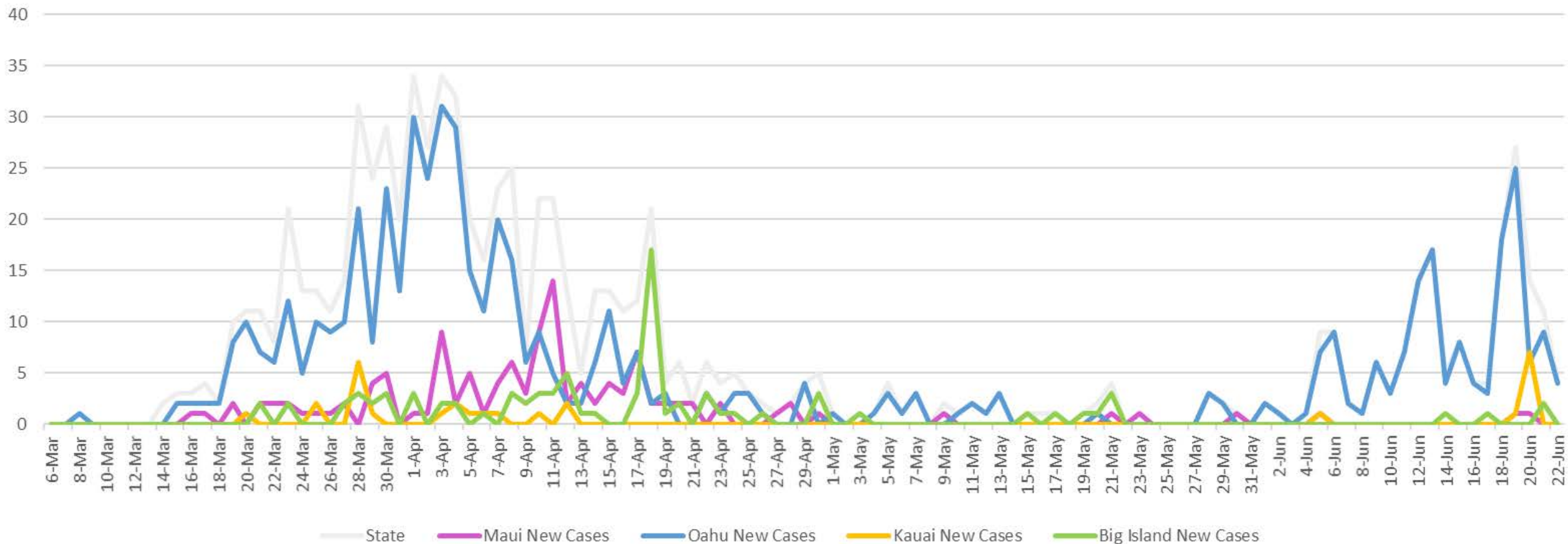

Hawaii COVID-19 New Daily Cases by County Over Time as of 6/22/20

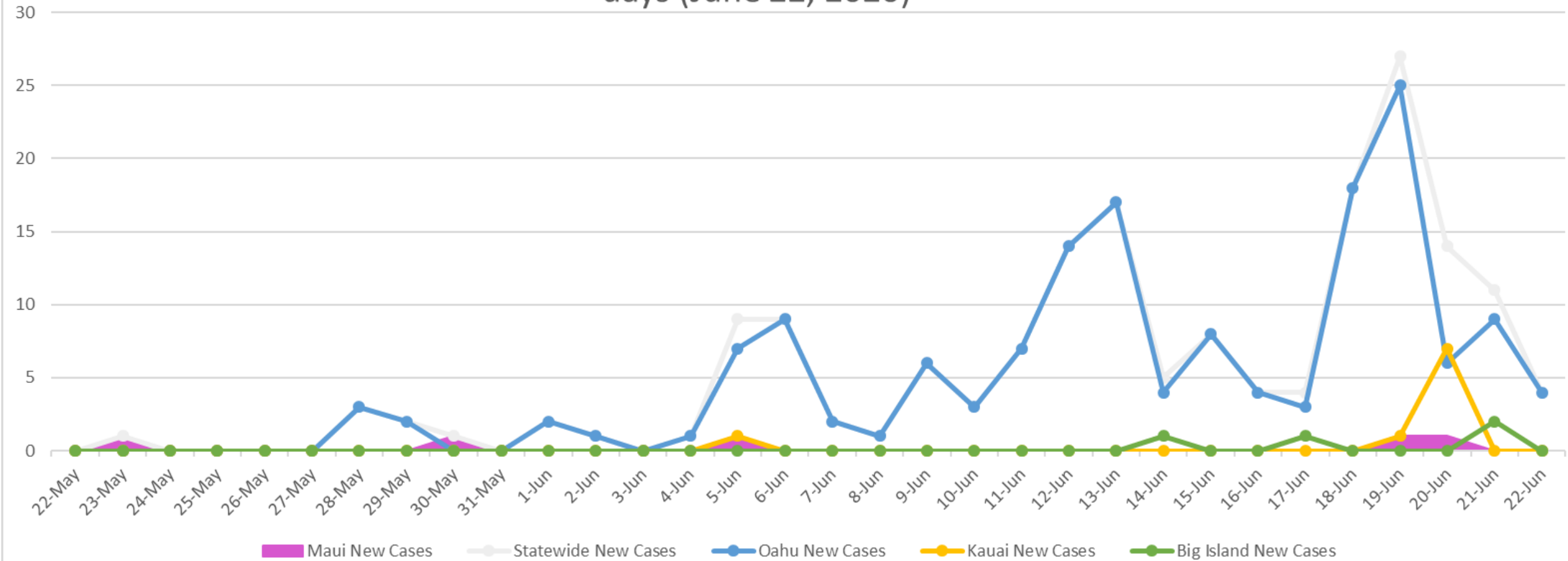

New Daily Cases by County over last 30 days (June 22, 2020)

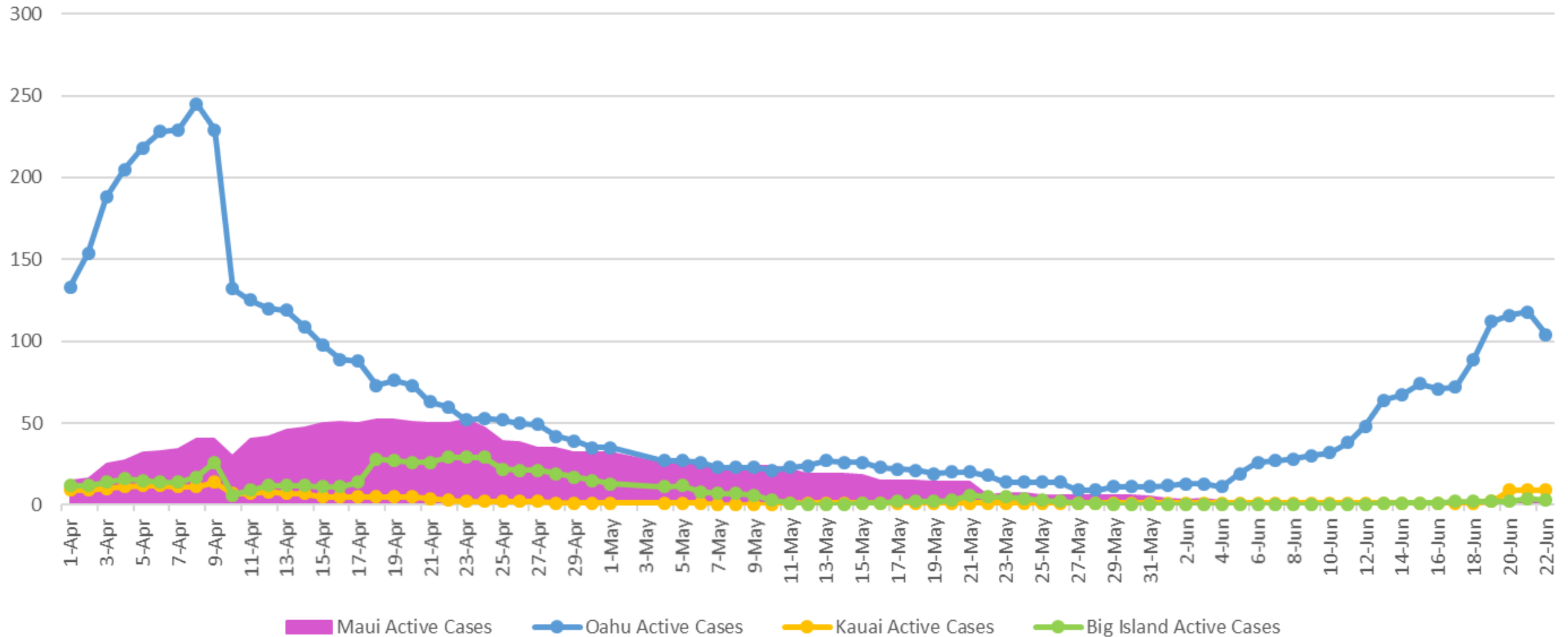

Active Cases in Isolation by Day by County (June 22, 2020)

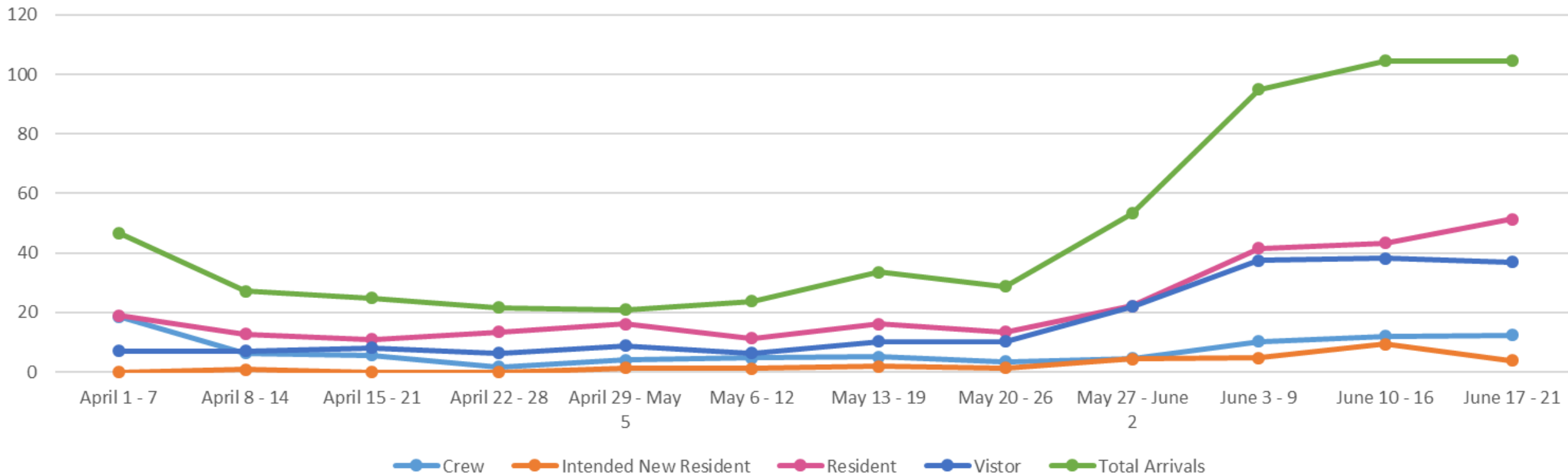

Maui County Testing Update

- Maui County has conducted about 9,500 tests with nearly 99% returning negative.
- Local providers continue to provide readily available testing on Maui, Molokai and Lanai.
- All you need to do is call and setup an appointment or talk with your doctor to get tested.

Drive-Through Testing from June 24-26

- Minit Medical Urgent care will be hosting three drive-through testing events in West Maui, South Maui and Central Maui.
- County parks and facilities hosting the events will have modified hours.
- **Wednesday, June 24:** Lahaina Aquatic Center from 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.
 - **The Lahaina Aquatic Center will be closed all day Wednesday.**
 - The Lahaina Recreational Parks will be open to the public from 2:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.

Drive-Through Testing from June 24-26

- **Thursday, June 25**: South Maui Community Park from 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.
 - The South Maui Community Park will be open to the public from 2:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.
- **Friday, June 26**: Keopuolani Regional Park from 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.
 - Keopuolani Regional Park will be open to the public from 3:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.

Minit Medical Urgent Care

Drive-Through Testing from June 24-26

- People can pre-register for the drive-through testing on Minit Medical's website at www.minitmed.com.
 - People can do same-day registration, but pre-registration saves time and avoids paperwork.
- Please bring the following:
 - Insurance Card
 - Identification
 - Facial Covering / Mask
- Results are expected back within 1 – 3 days, and Minit Medical will call with all results.

Drive-Through Testing from June 24-26

- Diagnostic and antibody testing will both be available.
 - Antibody tests are NOT covered by insurance, so those who do get the test will receive a bill from Clinical Labs of Hawaii for about \$45.
- Criteria for Molecular testing:
 - Symptomatic: fever/chills; body aches; short of breath; difficulty breathing; cough; loss of taste or smell; diarrhea; sore throat; headache.
 - Asymptomatic (with possible exposure): recent travel to Mainland/International; positive/possible exposure contact; first responders/essential workers; pre-operative, pre-procedure testing; required for travel (costs might be incurred).

Micro Business Loan Program Receives Additional \$750,000

- The Micro Business Loan Program has been extended with an additional \$750,000 from the County of Maui.
- The program, which started in April, was extremely popular and exhausted the initial \$1 million in about a month and a half.
- We want to give a special mahalo to Maui Chamber of Commerce and all of our partners who have served on the loan committee to assist our small businesses during this difficult time.

Micro Business Loan Program Update

- The County's Micro Business Loan Program approved and funded 60 small businesses in Maui County, with the initial \$1 million.
- Maui Chamber of Commerce currently has 52 applications pending, with one business approved and pending additional funds.
- A wide variety of businesses have been supported, including retail stores, restaurants, activities, printers, manufacturers, art galleries and construction-related services.
- The program provides 5-year loans of \$7,500 to \$15,000 and 7-year loans of \$15,001 to \$25,000.

Micro Business Loan Program Update

- Program qualifications for micro businesses:
 - 10 or fewer employees
 - Sales revenue of \$750,000 or less
 - Located in Maui County for at least a year prior to March 4, 2020, and registered to do business in Hawaii at that time.
 - Ability to create full- or part-time employment for low- to moderate-income residents
 - Demonstrate ability to repay the loan
 - Reasonable credit history and payment records

Kaunoa Senior Services Update

- **The Department of Housing and Human Concerns' Kaunoa Senior Services is maintaining Assisted Transportation and Home Delivered Meals services to eligible seniors in the community.**
- **The Leisure and Congregate Nutrition classes and activities will remain on hold at this time.**
 - **These programs will be re-established once all health and safety measures can be met to ensure the protection of our kupuna in the community.**

- **County of Maui Offices, including the Kalana O Maui Building, reopened today to the public.**
- **Public access to the County Building is from the second-floor lobby ONLY.**
- **The building is open during normal business hours from 7:45 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, except Holidays.**

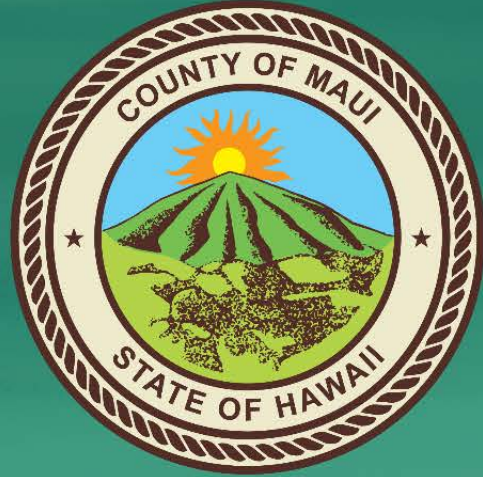
- The 8th Floor remains closed at this time.

Maui Wifi Bus Launching Wednesday

- **The Maui Bus will be launching its Wifi bus on Wednesday for a two-week trial period in East Maui.**
- **With many people working and learning from home, the Maui Wifi Bus helps communities in rural areas with limited access to reliable internet service.**
- **The Maui Wifi Bus will be fitted with antennas that can reach up to 500 feet.**
