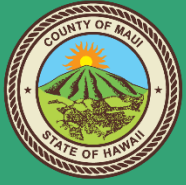

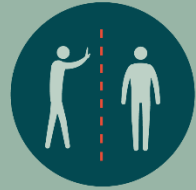

Housing Rental Assistance

- **The County of Maui reminds residents that rental assistance may be available to those who have lost their job or have reduced income by more than 25% as a direct result of COVID-19.**
- **Details include:**
 - **Household income at or below 60% AMI**
 - **Residents seeking a new lease**
 - **Rental subsidy is based on income**

Housing Rental Assistance

Program income limits:

- 1 Person - \$41,040
- 2 People - \$46,860
- 3 People - \$52,740
- 4 People - \$58,560
- 5 People - \$63,300
- 6 People - \$67,980
- 7 People - \$72,660
- 8 People - \$77,340

Housing Rental Assistance

- This Tenant Based Rental Assistance Program is made possible through a HUD Federal Block Grant through the HOME Program.

Drive-Through Testing from June 24-26

- Minit Medical Urgent care will be hosting three drive-through testing events in West Maui, South Maui and Central Maui.
- County parks and facilities hosting the events will have modified hours.
- **Wednesday, June 24:** Lahaina Aquatic Center from 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.
 - **The Lahaina Aquatic Center will be closed all day Wednesday.**
 - The Lahaina Recreational Parks will be open to the public from 2:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.

Drive-Through Testing from June 24-26

- **Thursday, June 25**: South Maui Community Park from 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.
 - The South Maui Community Park will be open to the public from 2:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.
- **Friday, June 26**: Keopuolani Regional Park from 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.
 - Keopuolani Regional Park will be open to the public from 3:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m.

Drive-Through Testing from June 24-26

- People can pre-register for the drive-through testing on Minit Medical's website at www.minitmed.com.
 - People can do same-day registration, but pre-registration saves time and avoids paperwork.
- Please bring the following:
 - Insurance Card
 - Identification
 - Facial Covering / Mask
- Results are expected back within 1 – 3 days, and Minit Medical will call with all results.

Drive-Through Testing from June 24-26

- Diagnostic and antibody testing will both be available.
 - Antibody tests are NOT covered by insurance, so those who do get the test will receive a bill from Clinical Labs of Hawaii for about \$45.
- Criteria for Molecular testing:
 - Symptomatic: fever/chills; body aches; short of breath; difficulty breathing; cough; loss of taste or smell; diarrhea; sore throat; headache.
 - Asymptomatic (with possible exposure): recent travel to Mainland/International; positive/possible exposure contact; first responders/essential workers; pre-operative, pre-procedure testing; required for travel (costs might be incurred).

County of Maui partners to launch Financial Opportunity Center

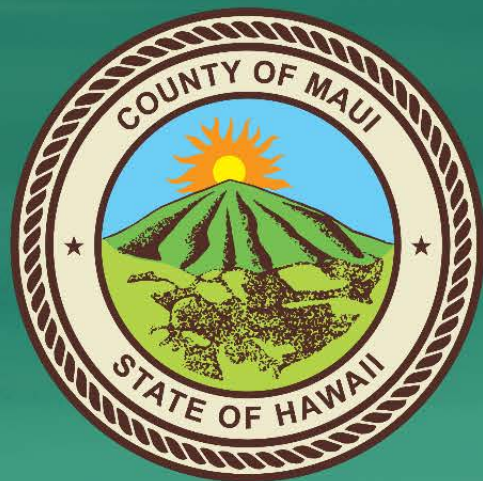
- **Mayor Victorino announced last week a partnership with the Hawaii Community Foundation and Hawaiian Community Assets to launch a Financial Opportunity Center that will help thousands of residents into housing.**
- **The County of Maui committed \$250,000 in matching funds for a total of \$500,000 to launch and operate the center.**

County of Maui partners to launch Financial Opportunity Center

- The center will assist 3,000 Maui County residents in qualifying for affordable rentals and mortgage financing over the course of three years targeting Maui families who live in poverty.
- The center also will provide residents with free financial coaching, grants and technical assistance to support employment and entrepreneurship.
