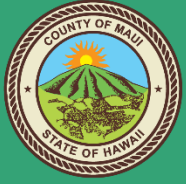

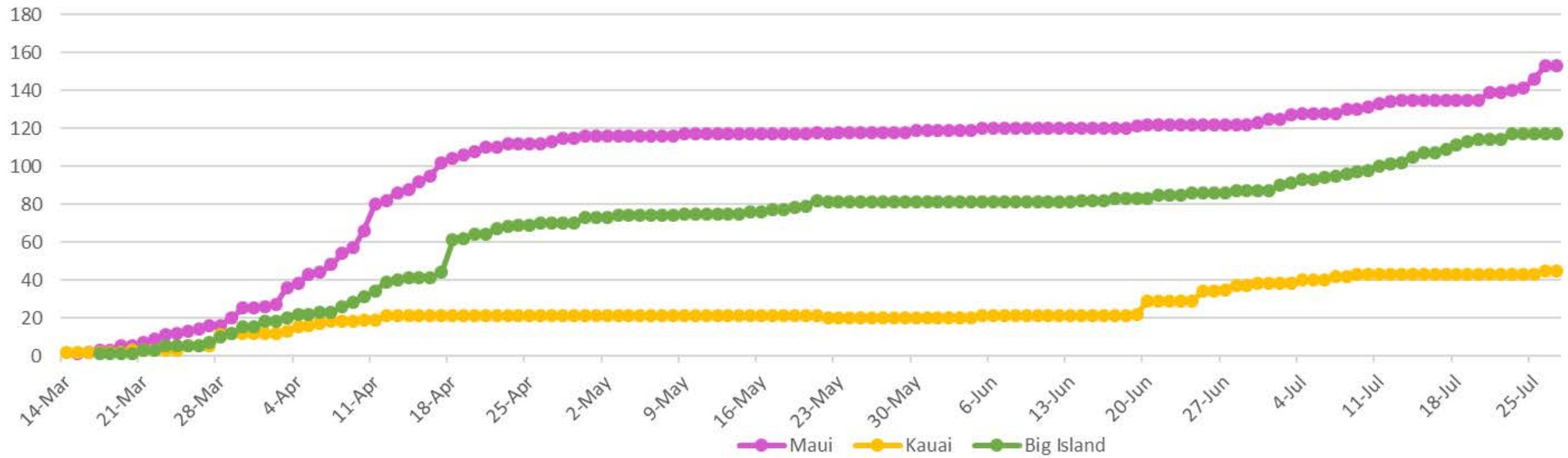

## Cumulative Total COVID-19 Cases in the Neighbor Island Counties (7/27/20)

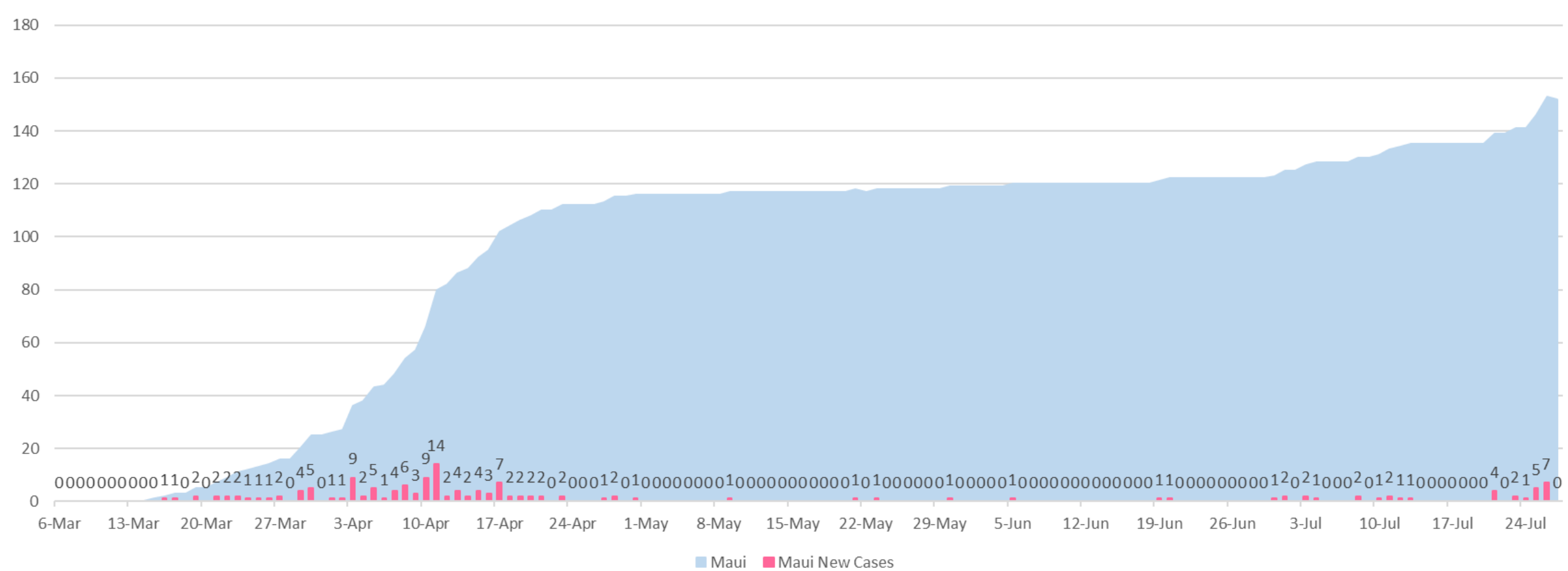

### Cumulative Maui Cases compared to New Cases by Day (7/27/20)

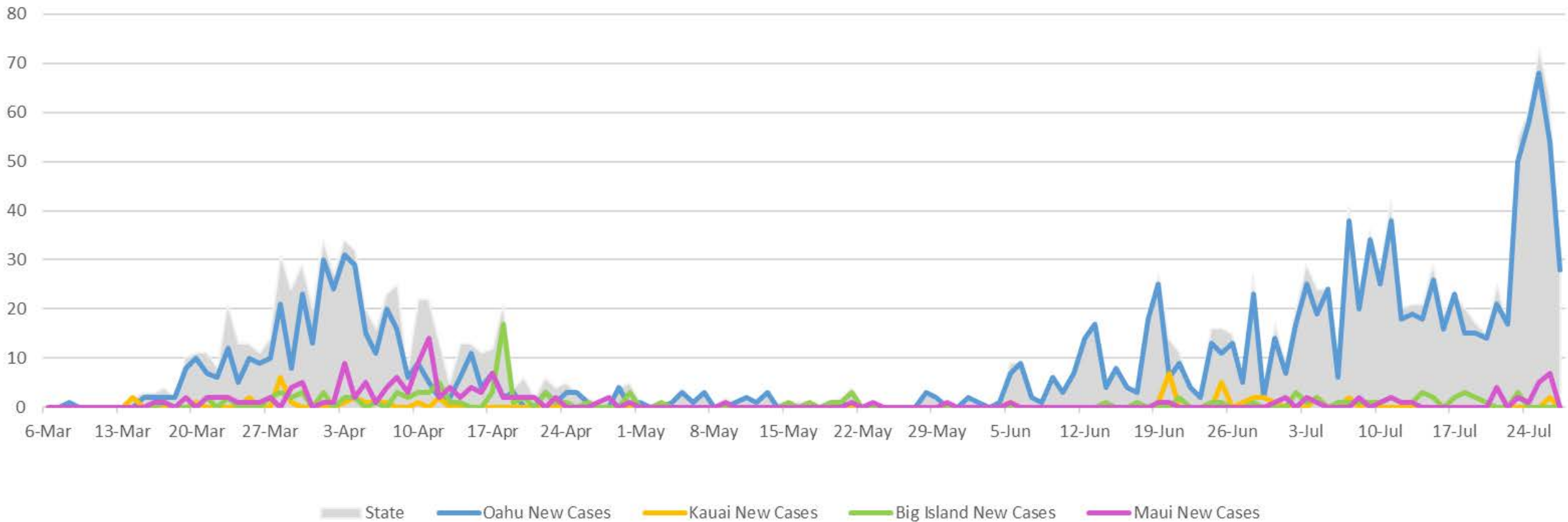

Hawaii COVID-19 New Daily Cases by County Over Time as of 7/27/20



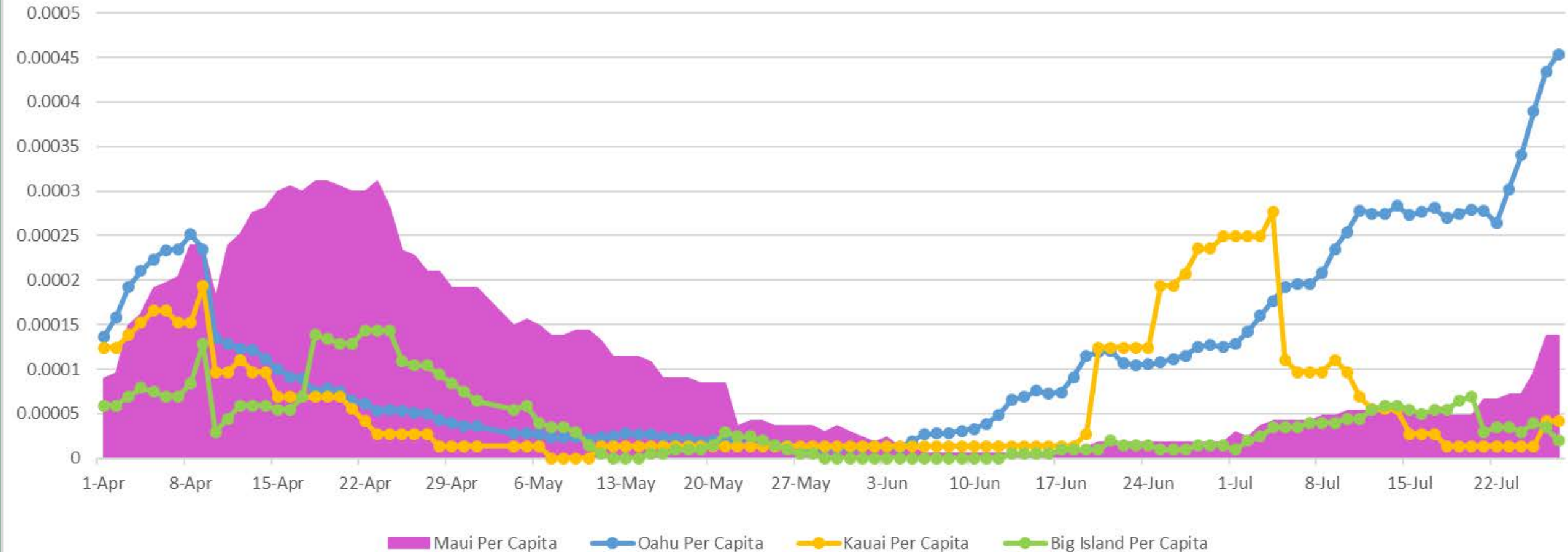

Active Cases in Isolation per Capita by County (July 27, 2020)

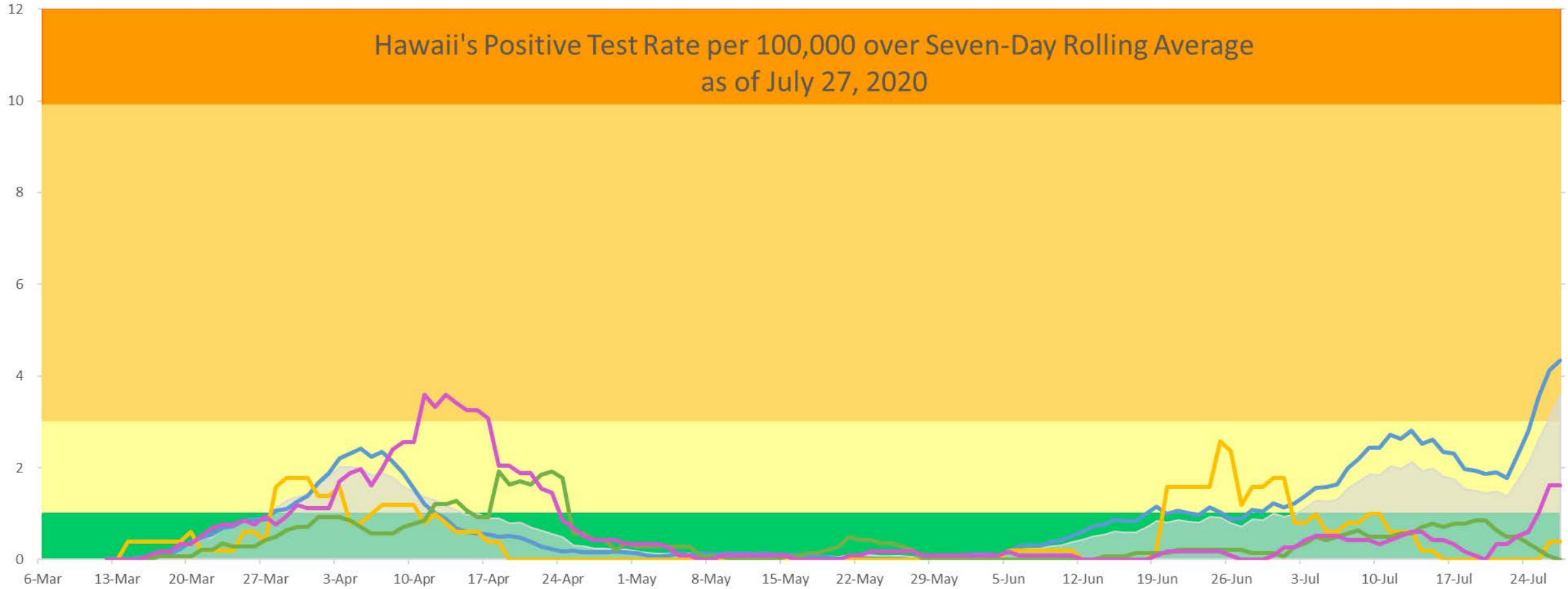

- Big Island Rolling Average per 100,000

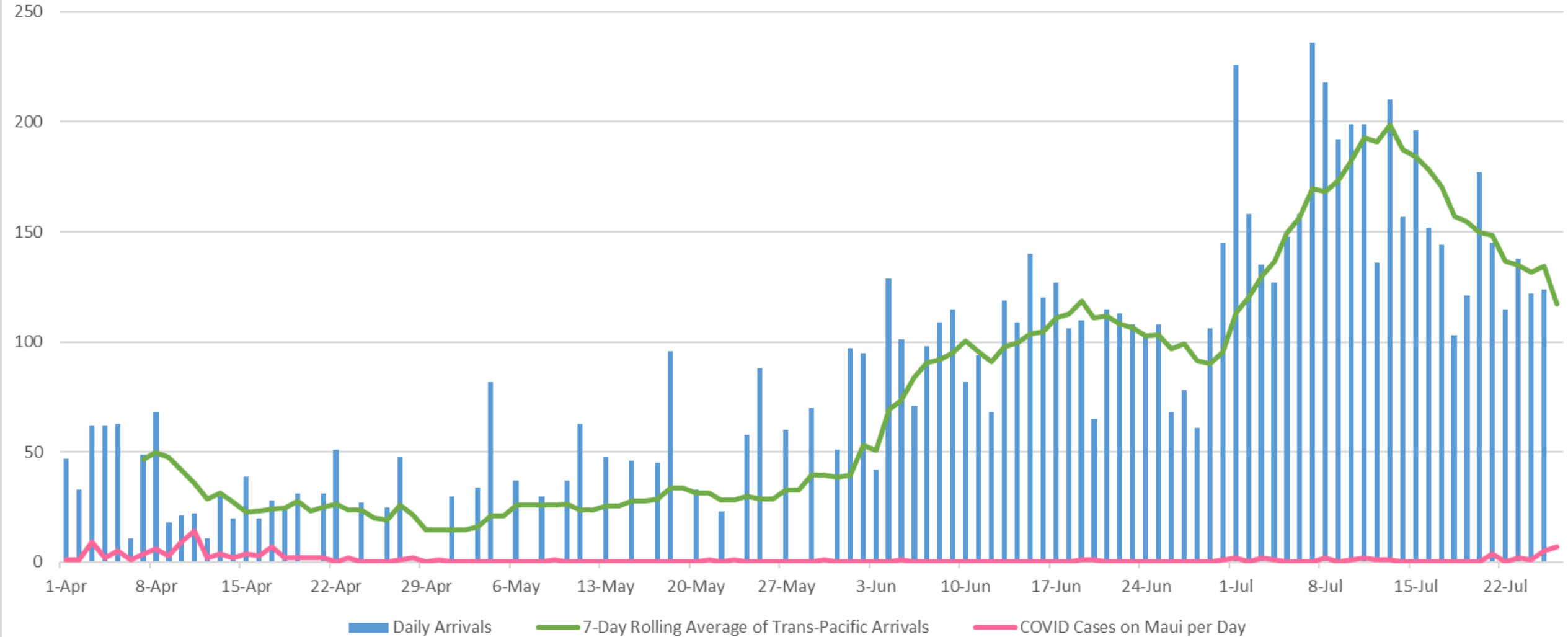
- Manageable within the State's Normal Resources

# Maui County Status Update

- The County of Maui has conducted over 13,500 tests with nearly 99% returning negative.
- About 40% of ICU beds and about 20% of ventilators are in use.
  - No ICU beds or ventilators are being used for COVID-19.

# Maui County Status Update

- **Statewide cases and hospitalizations are projected to continue rising, so everyone needs to remain vigilant and avoid large gatherings.**
- **Large parties and gatherings need to stop.**
- **Everyone should be wearing their face coverings/masks whenever they leave their home.**

# Hurricane Douglas Update

- Mahalo to our utility workers, first responders and County workers for keeping our community safe during Hurricane Douglas.
- There were no major damages reported from the storm aside from fallen trees, downed telephone poles and downed power lines.

# **County Parks, Pools Reopening Tomorrow**

- **County parks, pools and Waiehu Golf Course will reopen tomorrow, July 28.**
- **County offices and facilities reopened today as well as public transportation services.**
- **Mahalo to our County parks workers for cleaning up our parks and facilities for our community.**



# Central Maui Landfill and Refuse Pickup

- **Central Maui Landfill will reopen tomorrow following Hurricane Douglas.**
- **Monday's Residential Refuse Pickup that was suspended today will be picked up on Tuesday, July 28.**
- **Tuesday's Residential Refuse Pickup will be scheduled for Wednesday, July 29.**
  - **Essentially, refuse pickup will be pushed back a day for both Monday and Tuesday.**

# **Upcoming County Park Closures for maintenance**

- **The Hookipa Beach Park Restrooms and the Harold Rice Park restrooms will be closed for maintenance from August 3 – 7.**
- **Portable restrooms will be available in the parking lots of the two parks.**

# **Upcoming County Park Closures for maintenance**

- **The Waikapu Basketball Court will be closed from August 10 – November 7 for the construction of the Waikapu Park Play Court Lights project.**
  - **The project includes removal and replacement of existing sports lighting fixtures, poles and electrical equipment at the court.**
- **The public is asked to remain outside the construction area of all these projects for your safety.**

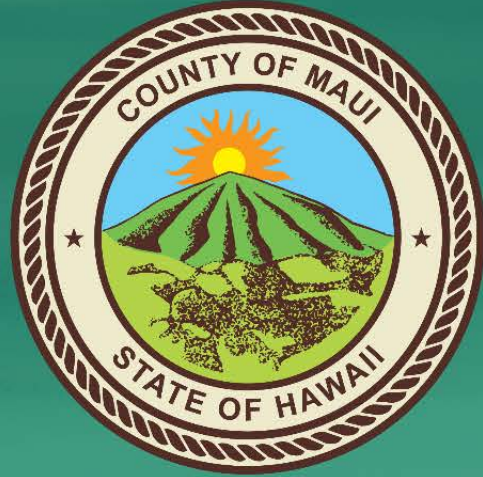
# Drive-Through Testing on Wednesday in Central Maui

- Drive-through COVID-19 testing will be held on Wednesday, July 29, at Keopuolani Regional Park.
- Testing will be administered by Minit Medical Urgent Care from 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.
- **IMPORTANT:** Keopuolani Regional Park will be closed all morning and open to the public at 3:00 p.m.

# **Drive-Through Testing on Friday in West Maui**

- **Drive-through COVID-19 testing will be held on Friday, July 31, at Lahaina Aquatic Center.**
- **Testing will be administered by Minit Medical Urgent Care from 9:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.**
- **Mahalo to Minit Medical, the Hawaii National Guard and our County Parks and Recreation for helping to provide this testing event for our community.**
