

Cumulative Total COVID-19 Cases in the Neighbor Island Counties (10/12/20)



Hawaii COVID-19 New Daily Cases by County as of 10/12/20



Cases per Day per Capita by County (October 12, 2020)







Governor Verbally Approves Maui County Requests

- **The Governor has verbally approved our request to allow Maui County residents to travel solely between Maui, Molokai and Lanai without having to quarantine for 14 days or take a pre-travel test.**
- **The Governor also verbally approved our request to allow intercounty travelers to participate in the pre-travel testing program.**
 - **This will allow travelers flying between counties to be exempt from quarantine if they provide a negative test within 72-hours prior to departure (Same as transpacific pre-travel testing program).**

Governor Verbally Approves Maui County Requests

- **We are still awaiting his formal written approval of our rules and will post them on our website after we receive them.**
- **We also are still working with the Governor, Attorney General and other County Mayors on the second test, or post-arrival test, for travelers arriving into Maui County.**

No quarantine required for travelers with a negative test 72-hours prior to arrival

Daily Case Counts: Less than 1 case per 100,000 per day

WE ARE HERE

ACT WITH CARE

No quarantine required for travelers with a negative test 72-hours prior to arrival

Daily Case Counts: 1-4.99 cases per 100,000 per day

Virus Control:
Test Positivity Rate of 1% - 2.49%

Masks required

High risk individuals should stay home

Gathering sizes limited

SAFER AT HOME

All incoming travelers subject to 14-day travel quarantine with limited exemptions

Daily Case Counts: 5-9.99 cases per 100,000 per day

Virus Control:
Test Positivity Rate of 2.5% - 5%

Moderate- to high-risk businesses may be closed

Non-essential travel limited

Residents should stay home as much as possible

STAY AT HOME

All incoming travelers subject to 14-day travel quarantine without exemption

Daily Case Counts: More than 10 cases per 100,000 per day

Virus Control:
Test Positivity Rate of more than 5%

All non-essential businesses closed

Only essential travel permitted

Residents are to stay at home


