Governor Approves Maui County Travel Rules

- **The Governor has approved the County of Maui's travel rules, which are now available on the County's website at MauiCounty.gov.**
- **This includes our rules for the Pre-Travel Testing Program for transpacific and intercounty travelers, as well as our voluntary post-arrival testing program.**

Governor Approves Maui County Travel Rules

- **These travel testing programs are part of our “Arrive Healthy, Stay Healthy and Return Home Healthy” campaign** to encourage travelers to Malama our community and keep our residents safe.
- Our visitors need to do their part to not only protect their families, but also protect our loved ones here in Maui County.

Maui County Pre-Travel Testing Program

- Maui County is moving forward with the Pre-Travel Testing Program for transpacific and intercounty travelers, starting Thursday, Oct. 15.
- A State-approved negative test must be completed by travelers 72-hours prior to departing for Maui County.
 - Travelers who DO NOT take a pre-travel test prior to departing for Maui County will be ordered to quarantine for 14 days or the length of their stay, whichever is shorter.
 - They **CANNOT** test out of quarantine.

Maui County Pre-Travel Testing Program

- Travelers awaiting their test result must quarantine until their negative results are verified by the State.
 - Travelers who receive a positive test result must immediately report to the Maui District Health Office and follow all directions from the State Department of Health.
- If a traveler has a connecting flight through Oahu and arriving into Maui County on the same day, they will not need to retest.
 - However, if a traveler coming from the mainland stays overnight on Oahu, then they will need to take another pre-test before departing for Maui County.

Maui County Pre-Travel Testing Program

- **Limited Quarantine Exemptions will still be available for essential (CISA) workers and medical appointments.**
- **We are working with the Governor on allowing Maui County residents to request a full quarantine exemption for medical and essential work purposes on Oahu, with a maximum of one overnight stay.**

Maui County Post-Arrival Testing Program


- Maui County's post-arrival testing program will be **VOLUNTARY** and travelers are asked to take the second test 72 hours after arriving into Maui County.

Maui County Post-Arrival Testing Program

- **The Stay Healthy Maui Nui Travel Testing Program details:**
 - The voluntary second test will be at no cost to the traveler.
 - Participating travelers will receive a Kama‘aina First “Mahalo Card,” which provides Kama‘aina discounts to hundreds of participating local vendors.
 - We have been working with the visitor industry and hotels on implementing designated, on-site testing locations.
 - We also are finalizing an agreement with a medical provider to roll out the County’s Post-Arrival Testing Program.

State of Hawaii Trusted Testing & Travel Partners

- As of Oct. 6, the State of Hawaii is **ONLY** accepting pre-travel testing results from trusted testing and travel partners.
