

With the new Maui County Tow & Scrap Pilot Program

Starting July 2023, Maui Island residents will be able to tow and scrap their personal junk and unwanted vehicles at no additional cost when using the new Maui County Tow and Scrap Pilot Program. Residents can call to schedule an appointment to have their unwanted car towed to Hammerhead Metals in Pu'unēnē. Residents need to follow the tow truck and their unwanted vehicle to Hammerhead Metals and turn in their vehicle title and other paperwork directly to the Hammerhead staff.

To participate you MUST:

- 1. Own the car you wish to Tow & Scrap.
2. Possess the vehicle title and a valid government ID. The name of the owner on the title must match the ID.
3. Use ONLY our Maui County Towing Vendors: either D&D Towing, or Maui Tow and Transport.
4. Follow the tow truck and your junk car to the vehicle disposal facility, Hammerhead Metals, to hand in your vehicle title to Hammerhead staff.
5. The car MUST be or have been last registered in Maui County. No out-of-county or out-of-state cars can use this program. Qualifying vehicles MUST be in an easily accessible location for tow drivers.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

Who do I call to schedule my tow appointment? Starting July 1, 2023 you may call either D&D Towing or Maui Tow and Transport depending on where you live on Maui Island. See image to the right:

Can I avoid going to Hammerhead Metals to hand in my paperwork there myself? No. You will be the only one handling your vehicle paperwork for this program. There are no exceptions. There is no way to avoid having to go to Hammerhead Metals to hand in your paperwork. Plan accordingly. If you do not go to Hammerhead Metals to hand in your paperwork, you will be charged the full cost of the tow and your car will not be disposed of.

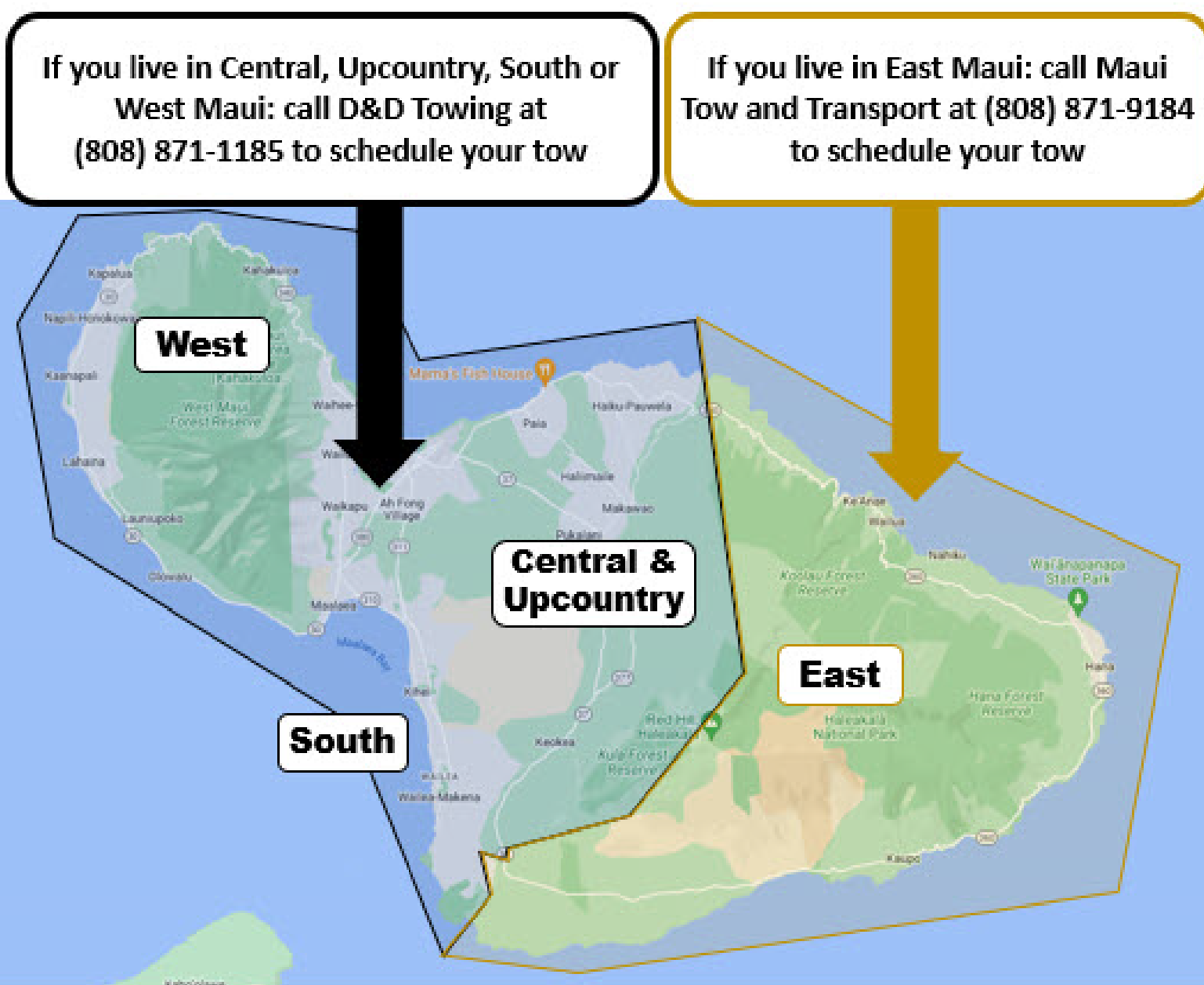
What if there are two owners of a vehicle? Both owners must go to Hammerhead Metals, present the title, and both of their identifications to junk the vehicle.

Do I need the registration card? No, you do not. The car does not need to be currently registered or have the current safety. The car MUST be or have been last registered in Maui County. No out-of-county or out-of-state cars can use this program.

Can I use Tow and Scrap to junk a car that I do not own which is on my property? No. This program is only for residents to scrap their own cars. You can hire your own tow company to dispose of abandoned vehicles on your property in accordance with Hawaii Revised Statutes 290-11 but you will pay for your own towing and disposal fees.

Can I scrap the car if the Notice of Transfer is signed to me at the top of the title? No, you must go to the DMV and have the title formally transferred into your name before utilizing the Maui County Tow and Scrap Pilot Program.

What if the car owner is deceased? If a death certificate is presented, then a representative will be allowed to scrap the vehicle of the deceased person. The vehicle title must match the death certificate. Call 808-270-6102 for assistance in this special circumstance.
