PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 103D, HRS, SEALED BIDS for Old Haleakala Highway Sidewalk Renovations, Job No. 12-15, **DISTRICT OF MAKAWAO, ISLAND OF MAUI**, will be received and time stamped by the Bid Receiver, Purchasing Division, Department of Finance, until 2:00 P.M., on

Thursday, May 15, 2014

at which time and place the sealed proposals will be publicly opened and read.

This project includes construction of approximately 2,000 LF of reinforced concrete sidewalk on the mauka side of Old Haleakala Highway from Loha Street to Kula Highway. The scope of work includes removal of obstructions; construction of intersection ramps; relocation of existing water meters and standpipes; installation of storm drainage features; pavement striping; traffic sign installation; grade wall installation; grass swales; and other incidental items.

Bids shall be submitted in a sealed envelope, and shall be on the Proposal Form provided on the compact disc furnished by said Department. Bids received after the established due date and time will not be considered.

To be eligible to bid, bidders must be licensed in accordance with Chapter 444, HRS, relating to the licensing of contractors.

The Hawaii Products Preference pursuant to Act 175, SLH 2009 is applicable to this project. Persons wishing to certify and quality a product as a Hawaii Product shall submit a Certification for Hawaii Product Preference (SPO form 38) for each product to Purchasing Division no later than **May 5th 2014** - 10 days before bid opening. Late submittals for this solicitation will not be reviewed by the County.

Contractors are hereby notified of the applicability of Section 11-205.5, HRS, which states that campaign contributions are prohibited from specified State or county government contractors during the term of the contract if the contractors are paid with funds appropriated by the legislative body.

The County of Maui, in accordance with the provisions of Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (78 Stat. 252) and the Regulations of the U.S. Department of Transportation (Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations Part 21) issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that the contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder without discrimination on the grounds of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, age, or disability.


The Equal Employment Opportunity Regulations of the Secretary of Labor implementing Executive Order 11246, as amended shall be complied with on this project.

Each proposal shall be on a form furnished by the Department of Public Works, County of Maui. The proposal guaranty shall be equal to at least five percent (5%) of the total amount of the bid submittal.

Estimated construction cost is between \$500,000.00 - \$1,000,000.00.
