

ORDINANCE NO. 4144

BILL NO. 49 (2014)

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING APPENDIX A  
OF THE FISCAL YEAR 2015 BUDGET FOR THE COUNTY OF MAUI  
AS IT PERTAINS TO PART II, SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUES -  
SCHEDULE OF REVOLVING/SPECIAL FUNDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015,  
AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND, KULAMALU AFFORDABLE HOUSING PROJECT

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE COUNTY OF MAUI:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 4133, Bill No. 37 (2014), as amended, "Fiscal Year 2015 Budget", Appendix A, Part II, Special Purpose Revenues – Schedule of Revolving/Special Funds for Fiscal Year 2015, is hereby amended as it pertains to the Affordable Housing Fund, by adding a proviso for the Kulamalu Affordable Housing Project related to the 2014 Affordable Housing Fund Annual Plan, to read as follows:

**"II. SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUES - SCHEDULE OF REVOLVING/SPECIAL FUNDS  
FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015**

(1) Provided, that no more than \$70,000 shall be for Administrative Expenses.			
(2) Provided, that \$1,000,000 shall be for planning, design and engineering of the Lanai Affordable Housing Project Phase I.			
(3) Provided, that \$780,000 shall be for the Na Hale O Maui Kahoma Project for the acquisition of 12 improved residential lots in the 100% affordable Kahoma subdivision.			
(4) Provided, that \$1,400,000 shall be for the Building Houses, Building Hope Project of Habitat for Humanity Maui for the acquisition, construction and rehabilitation of dwelling units for families and individuals with incomes at or below 80% of the area median income.			

- (5) Provided, that \$9,510,000 shall be for the Kulamalu Affordable Housing project of the County of Maui for the master planning, design and construction of 56 County-owned rental units in the Kulamalu subdivision for families earning between 50% and 120% of the area median income."

SECTION 2. New material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
