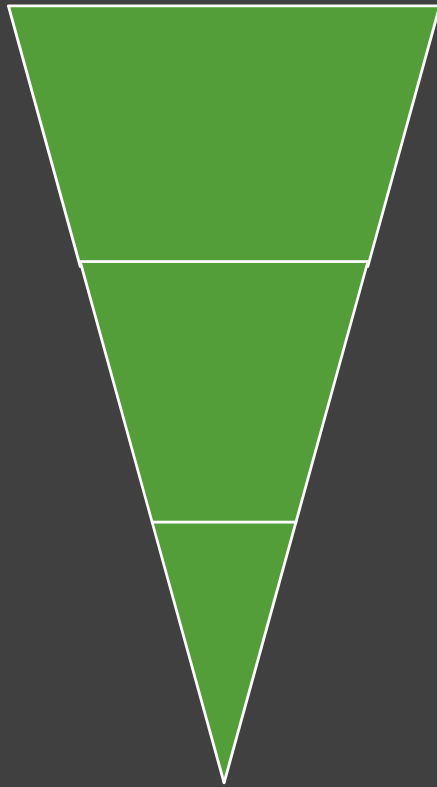

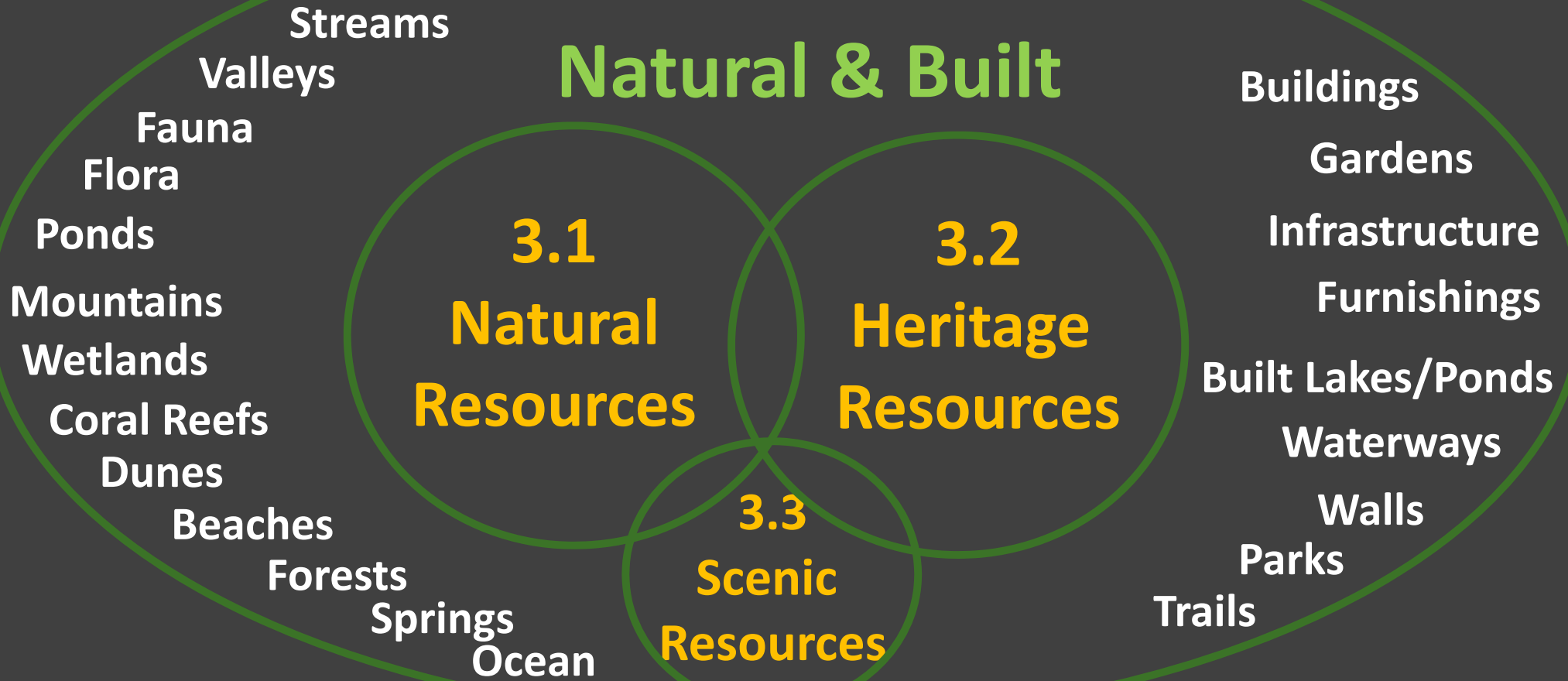

- ❖ Criteria or performance standards to provide quantitative measures for qualitative data.**
- ❖ 1981 Alaska – DNR -George Park’s Highway**
- ❖ 1996 Scenic America**
- ❖ Evaluate, Classify, Rating**

Environment – Scenic Resources

- ❖ **View: Corridors – Sheds – Points**
- ❖ **Classification: Natural – Urban – Rural – Agricultural**
- ❖ **Criteria: Land – Sky Interface, Waterform, Landform, Landcover, Surprise, Unique**
- ❖ **Criteria: Magnitude, Distinctiveness, Intactness, Draw**
