CAMPING FEES

Resident (State of Hawaii)

Monday—Thursday:

Adults (18 yrs. & older): \$5.00 per adult/per night

Minors (Under 18 yrs.): \$3.00 per minor/per night

Pets (Licensed dog): \$3.00 per pet/per night

Friday—Sunday / Holidays:

Adults (18 yrs. & older): \$10.00 per adult/per night

Minors (Under 18 yrs.): \$6.00 per minor/per night

Pets (Licensed dog): \$6.00 per pet/per night

Non-Resident

Monday—Thursday:

Adults (18 yrs. & older): \$10.00 per adult/per night

Minors (Under 18 yrs.): \$6.00 per minor/per night

Pets (Licensed dog): \$6.00 per pet/per night

Friday—Sunday / Holidays:

Adults (18 yrs. & older): \$20.00 per adult/per night

Minors (Under 18 yrs.): \$12.00 per minor/per night

Pets (Licensed dog): \$12.00 per pet/per night

**All camping fees must be paid in cash or money order
at the time of reservation. Fees are non-refundable.**



County of Maui Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR)

CAMPING INFORMATION

A camping permit is required to camp in DPR parks. Permits are given on a first come, first served basis and are limited to the following parks:

Kanaha Beach Park (Central Maui):

- Closed weekly for maintenance on: Monday and Tuesday
- Three (3) consecutive days maximum
- Limited availability: 12 campsites total

Papalaua Wayside Beach Park (West Maui):

- Closed weekly for maintenance on: Wednesday and Thursday
- Three (3) consecutive days maximum

One Ali'i Campground (Molokai):

- Three (3) consecutive days maximum

Papohaku Beach Park (Molokai):

- Three (3) consecutive days maximum

The following information must be provided to request a camping permit:

- Valid government-issued picture ID of applicant - *(18 years or older)*
- Address and phone number of applicant
- Full name(s) of any additional campers - *(Each campsite may have a maximum of 6 campers)*
- Tent color
- Vehicle: color, make, model and license plate number

**Campers are required to follow all DPR Campground
Guidelines and Rules.**
